

“Key to Revival” By Rev. Leslie Buckner

In the past you could hear the people praying as you entered the church parking lot. When they came out of the prayer rooms you did not have to pump and pry the people to get them excited about Jesus because they already were.

When you enter a church and hear the people praying you can be assured that you will have a great church service that night. I have witnessed it myself. When the people pray miracles happen in the church. If the saints of God will get the power of God in their lives the unsaved will come to church and get saved. We all make up a part of the church and we supply the needs of other people (*Ephesians 4*).

We are the temple of God. In Solomon’s temple they cut all the rocks and wood out in the mines and then they brought them into the temple. The pieces fit together so well that they did not hear the sound of the hammers or axe inside of the temple. That is what God expects of the church today. He wants us all to be a lively stone that is hewed of the Lord. If we are all lively stones we will be of a like mind, thus working well with one another and not causing a bunch of racket.

If you are a misfit you will be miserable. We do not do all of the hewing out in the church. The church is where we teach and put things together but our whole life, including outside of the church, is bringing ourselves to the place that we will fit together with other believers when we go to church. That is one of the things that I feel is not in operation today as it was in past times.

When alcoholics come to church and get saved the church gets full of people because he or she will go advertise what happened to them. A person that played carnal music on the radio and in clubs had a wife and kids that came to church and received salvation. He came to our church with his family on Easter and asked me what I would like for him to do. I said, “I would like for you to get saved and become a Sunday School Superintendent.” He just gave me a funny look and when he went home he wrestled with that thought for about a week.

One day he called and said, “I have got in my closet and I got

saved.” He read in the Bible that you should pray in your closet and he did. He later came to church and got gloriously filled with the Holy Ghost. He took his guitar to places and sang Christian songs and everyone began to listen to him. The town became stirred and the church became jam-packed with people and many received salvation.

If we will concentrate on getting one person saved they will and then they will go tell others about their experience with God and more people will get saved. I was often prayed for when I lived in Kansas. I became so miserable that I moved to Saint Louis, MO. The same Holy Ghost that was dealing with me in Kansas dealt with me in Saint Louis, MO. Finally I received salvation and then all my relatives that had never gone to church before started going to church and got saved a few months after I did. We need to keep praying for someone to receive salvation until the answer comes.

***Joel 2:15** Blow the trumpet in Zion, sanctify a fast, call a solemn assembly: 16 Gather the people, sanctify the congregation, assemble the elders, gather the children, and those that suck the breasts: let the bridegroom go forth of his chamber, and the bride out of her closet. 17 Let the priests, the ministers of the LORD, weep between the porch and the altar, and let them say, Spare thy people, O LORD, and give not thine heritage to reproach, that the heathen should rule over them:*

wherefore should they say among the people, Where is their God?

I do not want the people that are around me to say, “Where is his God?” God came to seek and to save those that are lost and He puts that desire on the inside of us. We are told to blow the trumpet, we need to sound the alarm and say something.

***John 17:17** Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.*

If we are going to be the temple of God we must be sanctified. When we are sanctified we are absolutely cleaned up and it prepares our vessel to be a temple of God. We must read the Word because we are sanctified by the truth in it. When we are prepared to be a sanctuary we will have our act together and be cleaned up spiritually. God will not dwell in an unclean temple and we are to be the temple of the Lord and of the Holy Ghost. We may not be doing what some would call a big sin but it is the little foxes that can spoil the vine.

***1 Corinthians 3:16** Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you? 17 If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is holy, which temple ye are. 18 Let no man deceive himself. If any man among you seemeth to be wise in this world, let him become a fool, that he may be wise.*

2 Corinthians 7:1 *Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.*

There are a lot of people that do not like the word holy nevertheless, holy is in the Bible and we need to strive to be it. In chapter six of Second Corinthians we are given many promises. As we read on into chapter seven we find that we need to cleanse ourselves from **all** filthiness of the flesh and spirit and perfect **holiness** in the fear of God in order to receive them. The formula for revival is to gather the people and sanctify the congregation. We are also to assemble the people, anything that is assembled works together in harmony.

Romans 12:1 *I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. 2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.*

2 Corinthians 10:5 *Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;*

Paul begged the people to present their bodies as a living sacrifice but he could not present their bodies for them. They had to make a choice to clean up their lives and be holy and acceptable to God in order to enter into the blessings of God. You cannot live (or think) like the world and have the real things of God manifested in your life. We need to renew our minds so that we will not get viruses in it like a computer might. When a computer gets a virus they will purge it in order for it to work properly again.

We need to purge our minds with the Word. When the devil does throw a carnal or sinful thought into our mind (which he will) we should not entertain it by laughing or indulging in it but on the contrary we need to cast it down as we would a poisonous snake. The more we do this the more the devil will not even be able to penetrate those wicked thoughts (remember the little foxes spoil the vine) into our minds. God wants everyone to be in His perfect will and we won't be if we are conformed to this world. The churches that are conformed to the world and teaching people to have the lust of the eye and the pride of life are out of the will of God.

We have either seen or heard of a lot of wicked things that happen in the world today and those things can pollute our minds. We may not be able to erase those things out of our minds but we can put them into the dormant area of our mind. You need to write down on a little sheet

of paper a scripture to memorize and when thoughts of evil things try to invade your mind pull out that scripture and meditate on the good things of God. If we have watched pornography, used drugs or alcohol in our past they may try to come back into our minds to haunt us but through Christ we have the power to cast those imaginations down! Satan may try to corrupt us but the Word cleanses us!

We should not be conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God (Romans 12:2).

Just watching sin on the television it can get into your mind and soul and can transform you into a confirmation of this world. As we read the Word and pray God will renew our minds. When we obey the things that Satan wants us to do we reap death, separation from God and condemnation. As we read the Word, pray and obey God will renew our minds. Thus, causing us to feel freedom and closeness to God.

God wants us to remain pure to Him so that He can cause us to be a building block in His church, what an awesome privilege. When we obey the things of God we reap blessings. When your mind is renewed in God you will feel as if you can run through a troop and leap over a wall but when your mind is bound by Satan you feel as if a troop just ran over you and you

were shoved into a wall by a MACK truck.

1 John 2:16 For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. 17 And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever.

Matthew 24:35 Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away.

Ephesians 5:26 That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, 27 That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

If we have the lust of the eyes and flesh we are not of the Father but of the world. The world will pass away but God's word will continue, sanctifying and cleansing. The first time we get sanctified is by the blood of Jesus and then the Word washes us.

1 Corinthians 6:18 Flee fornication. Every sin that a man doeth is without the body; but he that committeth fornication sinneth against his own body. 19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are

bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

Mark 1:3 *The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make his paths straight.*

Matthew 3:11 *I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire:*

We are not our own but we are bought with the precious blood of Jesus. If we want revival we must repent and be converted so that our sins can be blotted out and so that we can enter into the times of refreshing from the Lord (**Acts 3:19**). In order to receive the Holy Ghost and fire that God want us to have we have to have a temple that is prepared.

1 John 2:15 *Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.*

2 Timothy 3:4 *Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God;*

It is very sad to say but there are a lot of people that love the world more than they love Christ, who died for them. God did not tell us that we could not enjoy the things in our lives that give us joy, but that

we should not be lovers of pleasures **more than** lovers of God. We are in the world but we are not to be of the world because we are a temple of God, a sanctuary, a lively stone, filled with the Holy Ghost and the Word of God. We have the glory of God on the inside of us and we are filled with His love, we can look into the glory of God and be changed into His image and we are filled with the power of God.

You will be blessed and have a longer life if you are full of the Word of God and the Holy Ghost. Moses started in his ministry when he was eighty years old. What you need to do if you are having problems is to rise up and tell the devil that you and God are more than conquerors and that you have power to tread on serpents and scorpions and over all the power of the enemy.

Every time that you go through a battle and win the war someone will be watching you. I had a pastor friend that went through some rough trials and he told me that he did not think that he would have been able to make it through them had he not seen me go through my battles and get the victory. Someone is watching you. When you make it through your trial they will want the Jesus that is in you to be in them.

Titus 3:5 *Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;*

1 John 2:26 *These things have I written unto you concerning them that seduce you. 27 But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him.*

John 15:7 *If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.*

Romans 8:14 *For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.*

Romans 8:26 *Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.*

The Holy Ghost is our comforter, our teacher and he renews us. The Holy Ghost is our teacher so all ministers need the Holy Ghost to guide their sermons. If the Holy Ghost is on the inside of you, He will teach you a lot of things. If we will stay filled with the Holy Ghost, He will take over in the times of trouble. There are many things in this world that will try to distract us from getting full and staying full of the Holy Ghost.

The devil wants us to think of our problem instead of the answer

that God gave us in His Word. If you allow the devil to pull you down he will tell you that it is someone in the churches fault.

I once had a wonderful Pastor, but when he would preach on paying tithes I would get so mad at him because he had a brand new Oldsmobile parked outside of the church and I had an old Buick that I could barely get to church with. Of course I had to stop listening to the devil and listen to God. After I finally started paying my tithes I got a new car.

We cannot allow ourselves to get hindered by our thoughts, other people's lives, family problems or community problems. The world is not going to get any better *but if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you (Romans 8:11).*

We can feel better today than the day that we first got saved because we have had time to fellowship with the Father.

Galatians 6:1 *Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.*

If a person around you (neighbor, family member, church member) is overtaken in a fault you should restore them in the Spirit of meekness. If we do not restore them with meekness we will get all

bent out of shape with them and be tempted. God does not tempt us but we are tempted when we are drawn away with our own lust.

Galatians 6:7 *Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. 8 For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting. 9 And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.*

Acts 10:38 *How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.*

We have the same anointing and Holy Ghost as Jesus did. Jesus went about doing good and healing all that were oppressed of the devil regardless of what came against Him. Jesus was full of the Holy Ghost and prayed to the Father as you and I do. *Saying, "Father, if thou be willing, remove this cup from me: nevertheless not my will, but thine, be done" (Luke 22:42).* God gave us the same power that He gave His Son, Jesus. *Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father (John 14:12).*

Jesus is sitting at the right hand

of the Father and the church can do great and mighty works in God if it will get down to business and meet the criteria and standard.

Isaiah 59:19 *So shall they fear the name of the LORD from the west, and his glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him.*

It takes a standard to defeat the devil. If a husband, wife or child does not have a standard then they will never be able to defeat the devil. If the devil is trying to destroy you or your family you need to get down to business with sanctification, purity, Holy Ghost, Word and the blood of Jesus, which makes the devil tremble. We need to stay on guard and not allow ourselves to get weary in well doing because we will reap **if** we do not faint. The person who stays full of the Word of God, the Holy Ghost, keeps their mind renewed and their heart pure and does not get weary in well doing will reap a harvest. Moms, Dads and children will get saved that they have been praying years for.

Just the way that we live our life is an example to other people and that is why the devil tries to discourage us and cause us to get divorced or into some sort of sin. *Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us (Romans 8:37).*

Gather the people, sanctify the

congregation and assemble the elders, which will take the Holy Ghost. The Holy Ghost can assemble the families back together that have been torn apart by bitterness and sin.

The Lord is coming soon and we do not want Him to catch us asleep as He did the foolish virgins in chapter twenty-five of Matthew. In that parable there were five wise and five foolish virgins but there was also someone that stayed awake and warned the others when the bridegroom came. I want to be awake when the Bridegroom comes and one of the messengers that says, "Behold the Bridegroom is coming." Noah, Abraham and Samuel were messengers.

John 16:13 Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.

God can move in your church no matter what the size is. I was in a small church to preach revival and the pastor of that church was a carpenter. Something had happened to his arm and he was not able to raise it up to work with it. He came to the front to get prayed for and said that he believed God to heal him. As we prayed he immediately raised his hand and the next day he was able to go to work and drive nails.

What is Bible Way Association all about anyway?

Bible Way Association began in 1958 through a prayer meeting in the home of Rev. Leslie and Pauline Buckner in St. Louis Missouri. Early in this ministry God began to reveal his will and purpose through visions that were confirmed and strengthened through the years. The result of following the will of God as delivered is Bible Way Association as it is today.

The vision and purpose of Bible Way Association, and all of its Departments, is ultimately the same identical purpose and goal as each church or ministry has, to reach another soul for God. If this were not true there would be little purpose for joining in membership with the Association.

There have been a few who only joined together for their benefit alone and whose only reason was to suck out of the Association what good they could to maintain themselves without ever putting back into the work. God confirmed this to Brother Buckner through a vision early on concerning the lamprey eel which attaches itself to the host fish, taking a free ride and drawing the life giving blood to sustain itself without regard to the resulting weakness to the host.

If we truly are a part of this Association because we are closely attached by vision, purpose and goal, shouldn't it compel us to pull together, to fight together and to have victory together for the glory of God, seeing increase on all sides.

1Thessalonians 5:12 And we beseech you, brethren, to know them which labour among you, and are over you in the Lord, and admonish you;

Ephesians 4:1 I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that ye walk worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called,

1Corinthians 1:10 Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.

1Thessalonians 4:1 Furthermore then we beseech you, brethren, and exhort you by the Lord Jesus, that as ye have received of us how ye ought to walk and to please God, so ye would abound more and more.

Bible Way Association labors to charter, establish and enable places of worship in local areas where they are so desperately needed. Every church or ministry that is affiliated in any way with the Association is backed up and enabled by what the Association has to offer, else they would not be a part of it. As workers together with your ministry one of our goals is to enable your ministry to work legally to the best of its ability under our coverage as well as sharing ecclesiastic vision of the true foundation of Jesus

Christ in the Word of God and the impartation of the anointing of the Holy Ghost to help accomplish God's purpose.

Furthermore, our goal is also to establish and maintain common grounds and support ministries through the Camp Grounds and other Departments where we can truly work together, bringing our individual strengths and receiving more of what God has to offer each of us.

It takes every ministry working together, through the ministry God has entrusted to them, to accomplish the greater purpose of reaching more for the Kingdom of God before it is too late.

2 Timothy 4:5 But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry.

The Apostle Paul was one of the greatest ministers of all times. He recognized the power and necessity of each individual gift and calling of God and exhorted each one to follow the Lord closely to accomplish God's will and purpose for them.

He also recognized the power and necessity of unified ministry and how much more could be done working together. All of our individual calls to ministry, as well as our collective calls to ministry, have only one purpose and goal, that God will give the increase and receive all of the glory. After all, it is ultimately God's ministry, isn't it?

1 Corinthians 3:7 So then neither is he that planteth any thing, neither he that watereth; but God that giveth the increase.

3:8 Now he that planteth and he that watereth are one: and every man shall receive his own reward according to his own labour.

3:9 For we are labourers together with God: ye are God's husbandry, ye are God's building.

Without the Camp Grounds we would not be able to come together as we have done in years past and receive of God's anointing and share our vision and strengths. Brother Buckner has shared his understanding and vision such as the Bee Theory many times compelling us to come and receive so we can take our anointing back to other who could not come.

Without the Missions Departments we could not reach out collectively as we do to help others. The primary purpose for which the Home Missions Department was founded was to help build and establish new churches and ministries. This is not as simple as acquiring a building or paying the expenses involved. A new church or work in the ministry requires first of all someone who has a call to service and a vision from the Lord to win souls and establish the Kingdom of God. This vision must be in the heart and soul of any minister who reaches forward to plant and establish a work for the Lord. Home Missions Department will endeavor to support this type of vision and labors for God's glory.

This Department has also been able to help several churches this year. Some of the churches were in great need just to keep the bills paid while other were in need of repairs or improvements. It has taken everything that

has come in to the Home Missions Department with very little to spare to accomplish this. Either way it is a great blessing to the Association and the supporters to assist them when they were in need.

The vision of this Department isn't to just get by, but to excel and see growth. This growth is not monetary growth, but seeking new souls. Churches are foundational works that have a purpose of saving and establishing people in salvation, sanctification and grace under the leadership of the Holy Ghost. Some might argue that there are too many churches already, why establish another. The simple truth is that if what is currently available and active would suffice, those churches would be winning souls and being filled with established Christians, however, few are. If one more soul can be converted to the ways of salvation and established in sanctification and the grace of God, then isn't it worth every prayer and effort, and even every dollar that can be raised and spent to help make this happen? Many times it is the church hardened prodigals, those who have been in many churches in times past who have been wounded and often won't return, who often become among the first to be won in a new work for the Lord. If even one can be reconciled to the Lord it is worth it all!

Proverbs 11:30 The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life; and he that winneth souls is wise.

Without the Teaching Department we would not have literature and courses and would have to look elsewhere for literature that is founded in sound doctrine and scripture using the King James Version of the Bible.

Without the Voice of Truth World Outreach Ministries Division there would be no media produced to send to ministers, missionaries, nursing homes, prisons or shut-ins.

Each Department has been established to do our part collectively in reaching others with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Please pray about your part in this collective ministry and how you could participate more and help more. The full collection efforts for the various Camp Meetings have been very successful and appreciated.


We are happy to announce our latest Adult Bible Study volume, "FAITH AND THE UNSEEN".
