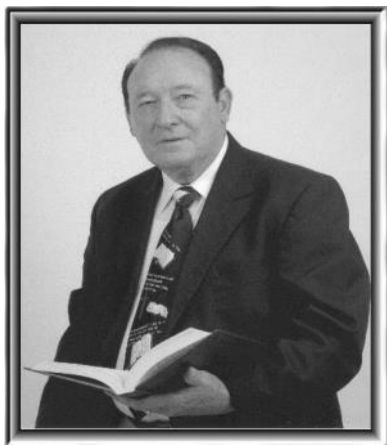

Followers and Leaders

Hebrews 6:1 *Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto perfection; not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works, and of faith toward God, 8 But that which beareth thorns and briars is rejected, and is nigh unto cursing; whose end is to be burned.*

We should be striving for perfection or maturity and not leave the doctrines of Christ, bearing fruit and not thorns. Someone gave me a Bible lesson about geese and it states that as each bird flaps its wings it creates uplift for the bird following. By flying in a V formation the entire flock adds seventy-one percent greater flying range than if the bird flew alone. The goose in the front has to be the strongest, and the next one behind is lifted up by it as that process goes down the line. The smallest geese are the ones that stay in the back. If one goose gets out of line it quickly gets back into line because flying is harder when out of line.

The Bible lesson to that story is that people who share in a common direction and sense of community can get to

where they are going quicker and easier because they are traveling on the thrust of one another. Pentecostal, Full Gospel and Charismatic need to learn that we are traveling on the thrust of one another. We need to go the same direction and share one another's burden, which is fellowship. In the line of the geese the smaller goose would never be put in the front. Sometimes there is a problem in the church because the youngest in Christ is put in front as the leader.

During a fellowship meeting there was a young Christian who wanted to preach, the Lord instructed me that I could let him. Several different times he would preach about five minutes and run out of things to say and hand me the microphone back. The geese change positions sometimes to allow the leader to refresh itself and rest but they always remember that the leader is the big goose that has been north and south several times, it has power in its wings and has a sense of direction.

We need to have as much sense as the goose and stay in formation with those who know where they are headed and be willing to accept their help as well as give our help to others. The geese in formation honk from behind so that they can encourage those in front to keep up their speed. We need to make sure the noise we are making from behind is encouraging. If a goose gets sick or wounded one of the bigger geese, or the mother or father, drops out of line to go down with it, they share the burden.

Hebrews 6:11 *And we desire that every one of you do shew the same diligence to the full assurance of hope unto the end: 12 That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises. 13 For when God made promise to Abraham, because he could swear by no greater, he swore by himself, 14 Saying, Surely*

blessing I will bless thee, and multiplying I will multiply thee. 15 And so, after he had patiently endured, he obtained the promise.

Ephesians 4:11 *And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; 12 For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ: 13 Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ: 14 That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive; 15 But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ:*

1 Corinthians 12:28 *And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues. 29 Are all apostles? are all prophets? are all teachers? are all workers of miracles?*

The geese have a purpose to either fly north or south. The air gives the geese resistance but it is also what keeps them up. The Bible says that we should be going for perfection (**Hebrews 6:11**). If you do not have an objective to do something, you will do nothing. The problem with the church, nation and home is the leadership and following. God is the one that sets prophets, teachers, gifts, helps, governments and diversities of tongues in the church. Everyone is commanded to heal the sick but everyone is not called to be in leadership. We will either “fly” the way God wants us to or we will be in a struggle all of our life. The way of the transgres-

sor is hard. It is wonderful when the church falls into line the way that God desires.

Numbers 12:2 *And they said, Hath the LORD indeed spoken only by Moses? hath he not spoken also by us? And the LORD heard it.*

The organization that accomplishes its goal will have a leader and an assistant leader behind them. The assistant leaders will not try to go ahead of the leader. In the World War II they chose a General in the Pacific and a Supreme Commander in the Atlantic. General Eisenhower was the one chosen above the English because he was more qualified and the leaders behind him helped him win the war. There are people today that do not know how to follow leaders. In the Old Testament those people were the ones that said, “Is Moses the only one that hears from God?”

Ephesians 6:13 *Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. 14 Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; 15 And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; 16 Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. 17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: 18 Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;*

Christ is the Supreme Commander and we are His generals and officers. In the war the Corporal had the orders and the artillery, but he did not personally talk to the President everyday. As Christians we have the equipment and the power to do the job God commanded us

to do. We should put on the armor of God and stand against the enemy.

Hebrews 12:11 *Now no chastening for the present seemeth to be joyous, but grievous: nevertheless afterward it yieldeth the peaceable fruit of righteousness unto them which are exercised thereby.*

2 Timothy 3:16 *All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: 17 That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.*

The Word of God is profitable for sound doctrine, the apostle's doctrine, good doctrine and the doctrine of Christ. It is not foolish doctrine. The Word of God is given to us for reproof, correction and to instruct us in the ways of righteousness so that we may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works. No chastising seems to be pleasant but afterwards it works the peaceable fruit of righteousness.

Joel 3:14 *Multitudes, multitudes in the valley of decision: for the day of the LORD is near in the valley of decision.*

The geese bring more geese along with them when they fly north in the springtime. If there are only four geese they will still fly south for the winter, they will not stay on a frozen pond. The church needs to realize that it needs to go somewhere in Christ whether anyone else has left or not. In order to grow in the things of God we are going to have to have a vision. There are multitudes of people in the valley of decision and the day of the Lord is near. We are going to have to get our "wings moving" and move with God while providing help for someone behind us.

Acts 2:46 *And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and*

breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart, 47 Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved.

Proverbs 11:30 *The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life; and he that winneth souls is wise.*

We need to produce something, striving to win souls. The disciples went from house to house and broke bread, ate meat with gladness and singleness of heart, praised God and had favor with the people and God added to the church daily such as should be saved. If you are wise you will win souls and unity produces souls.

There was a Baptist church that began to get filled with the Holy Ghost and someone recommended a preacher come speak at that church, so they invited him. When that speaker left everyone in that church thought they were apostles and prophets and the preacher was "just a pastor." The Pastor said that the church became in disarray and there was nothing he could do to help them, because they would not listen to him. Today the devil has got the leaders and followers so out of order that there are several churches in disarray. Satan comes as an angel of light and he has ministers too, that have anointed themselves.

1 Thessalonians 5:12 *And we beseech you, brethren, to know them which labour among you, and are over you in the Lord, and admonish you;*

I believe in personal prophecy, gifts of the Spirit, tongues and interpretations but we need to get them into God's perfect order, as the Spirit gives utterance (**Acts 2:4**). Pastors need the Holy Ghost and for the people to get behind the Word of God and follow someone that

has done a good work for God. You cannot follow everyone that makes you feel good, you need to know for certain that they are following Christ.

1 Samuel 15:23 *For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry. Because thou hast rejected the word of the LORD, he hath also rejected thee from being king.*

We have a world full of rebellion and in the past few years there have been churches in rebellion. There are also houses full of rebellion in the lives of the mothers, fathers and children. Nations are being shaken, there are wars and rumors of wars and five and a half billion people are dying of starvation because of the rebellion, that is in the world. Part of Los Angeles burnt down because of rebellion and rebellion is sin. We should get behind our leadership in church and not walk in rebellion.

Proverbs 16:25 *There is a way that seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death.*

John 14:6 *Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.*

I have been in the ministry for many years and I have seen a lot of people that have gotten behind the wrong ministry. If you are weak in the Lord you need to get behind a leader that is strong in Christ.

2 Peter 1:3 *According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue: 4 Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.*

God spoke to Moses, Abraham and Joseph face to face. Christians should have the characteristics of Christ not the

characteristics of the world. Sometimes in order to have the nature of God you can look at the world and do exactly opposite of what it is doing. If there is a church member that is rebellious and disobedient you should do exactly opposite of what they tell you to do.

John 6:65 *And he said, Therefore said I unto you, that no man can come unto me, except it were given unto him of my Father. 66 From that time many of his disciples went back, and walked no more with him. 67 Then said Jesus unto the twelve, Will ye also go away? 68 Then Simon Peter answered him, Lord, to whom shall we go? thou hast the words of eternal life.*

After one of the first messages from Jesus several people stopped following Him. Jesus gave the twelve disciples a chance to stop following Him when he asked them if they would go away also. Then Simon Peter said, Lord, to whom shall we go? Thou hast the words of eternal life (**John 6:68**). If there is only ten, two or just me left I am going to hang on to Jesus and shout the victory. I have no other place to go and I have nothing to lose and everything to gain. We need to enjoy the blessings of the Lord.

2 Timothy 4:2 *Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. 3 For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; 4 And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables. 5 But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry. 6 For I am now ready to be offered, and the time of my departure is at hand. 7 I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the*

faith: 8 Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing.

A fable is a false story and we need the truth in church, not fables that just make us feel comfortable or make us laugh. There is a crown of righteousness for all them that love His appearing, the people that are doing something for God. Paul taught Timothy the truth and ministers today need to teach the truth.

Hebrews 12:23 *To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect,*

2 Timothy 3:7 *Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth.*

Paul had some people that had great Spirits, you cannot come to the knowledge of the truth unless you have the Spirit of truth. We have to get our spirit perfected before we can learn what God's Word has to say to us.

Titus was a teachable man. To be a high-quality follower you must be hungry. You will never become a leader until you learn how to become a follower. Jesus said, *"Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men."* (**Matthew 4:19**) Three and a half years later Jesus made those same men leaders.

We would like to start a church with twelve hundred people, but Jesus started with twelve. Jesus spent three and a half years with twelve people and one of them was a rascal. Some one told me they were hunting a church that did not have any problems. I asked them were they would find a church like that. The church would lose its purpose if it did not have any problems, it is there to solve problems. We need people in the

church that are able to solve problems because the Pastor and his wife cannot do it all. We should try to be the people that help solve problems and not create them.

Philippians 4:11 *Not that I speak in respect of want: for I have learned, in whatsoever state I am, therewith to be content.*

We must be obedient, humble, and teachable in order to become a good follower. We also need to learn to be content in whatever state we are in (**Philippians 4:11**). We need to be able to shout if the church is full or not. Paul and Silas praised God and had revival when they were beaten. If we are not content we will go from church to church and what we need to do is settle down and focus on winning souls.

We need to have a spirit of order and unity that always wants to improve things until we all come in the unity of faith in the knowledge of the Son of God (**Ephesians 4:13**). Jesus taught the disciples to be fishers of men. We have to take time to train followers and sometimes that is by our actions because people are watching the way we operate. The Jehovah Witnesses do not take anyone to church until they have trained him or her for one year. They want the people to be fully trained in their doctrine.

A good follower will always lead someone to the Lord, and it does not only have to happen behind the pulpit. There was a church in New York that grew by leaps and bounds and the Pastor said the reason it grew was because he preached to the congregation that they needed to strive to lead people to Christ and they did. Every one in church can win a soul for Jesus and start training them in how to live for God. If you spend only one hour a week with a new

convert, whom you have led to the Lord, you will spend fifty-two hours with them in a year. If everyone in the congregation would spend that time with new converts teaching them how to be followers of God, faithful, strong and obedient all the churches would have to be built larger. If the geese are out of order this will not be accomplished.

Titus 1:5 *For this cause left I thee in Crete, that thou shouldest set in order the things that are wanting, and ordain elders in every city, as I had appointed thee: 10 For there are many unruly and vain talkers and deceivers, specially they of the circumcision:*

Paul was able to leave Titus in Crete, so that Titus could set things in order. The people that were in Crete had many things that needed to be corrected in their lives. Paul trusted that Titus would be able to handle the situation because Paul probably spent a long time training him.

In my ministry I spent many years trying to find someone that was already trained and then I would find out that they were trained incorrectly. In First and Second Samuel David trained many mighty men himself.

The church needs to get themselves spiritually fit, then get behind their Pastor and help him train many mighty men. Then you will be able to run through a troop and leap over a wall and get water from the well as David's men did. We need to hold fast to the quality, integrity and certification of the Word of God and become good followers and then God will make us leaders. Sheep produce sheep and animals produce animals after the kind that they are and we need to produce Followers of God.

The first person that I lead to Christ was my cousin when he was around twenty years old. He was an epileptic all of his life and had many epileptic sei-

zures. We took him to church and won him for God and he has never had another epileptic seizure after that day. We had a contest at our church to see who could get the most people to come to church and he got more people than the rest of the congregation put together, his testimony is what drew people in. God can use you to lead people to the House of God, you can lead souls to Christ whether you are young, old, middle aged, teenager or even a child.

James 4:17 *Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin.*

It is easy to be a forgetful hearer, hearing a message and not doing it.

Proverbs 11:30 *The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life; and he that winneth souls is wise.*

God spoke to me about the teaching of the geese and told me that it is time for the church to hatch out a new bunch of geese; it is time to win souls for Christ. We need to rise up and nurture the hatchlings until they become strong and fly with us. It is up to every individual to find their sense of direction and follow something that will lead them closer to Christ. Jesus said that God was always with Him and He always did that which pleased Him. The world is short on followers and leaders. Some young person reading this could be one of the greatest leaders to lead young people to God and someone else reading this could have a soul winning ministry that will win more people to God than anyone before.

So will you join with me and come into unity of the Spirit and become the best follower or leader that God has called you to be?

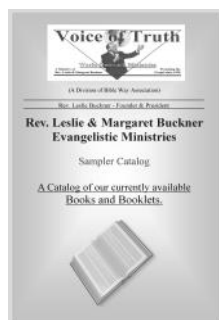

Genesis 1:26 *And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. 27 So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. 28 And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.*

In **Genesis Chapter 1 verses 26 to 28** we understand that God created man in his own image, creating them male and female instructing them to be fruitful and multiply in order to subdue the earth, having dominion over it and the other creatures that He had created. It is not hard for those who have the mind of Christ to understand the plan of God for mankind based upon these scriptures alone.

2 Timothy 3:1 ***This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come. 2 For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, 3 Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good, 4 Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God; 5 Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away. 6 For of this sort are they which creep into houses, and lead captive silly women laden with sins, led away with divers lusts, 7 Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth. 8 Now as Jannes and Jambres withstood Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, reprobate concerning the faith. 9 But they shall proceed no further: for their folly shall be manifest unto all men, as theirs also was. 10 But thou hast fully known my doctrine, manner of life, purpose, faith, longsuffering, charity, patience, 11 Persecutions, afflictions, which came unto me at Antioch, at Iconium, at Lystra; what persecutions I endured: but out of them all the Lord delivered me. 12 Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution. 13 But evil men and seducers shall wax worse and worse, deceiving, and being deceived. 14 But continue thou in the things which thou hast learned and hast been assured of, knowing of whom thou hast learned them; 15 And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. 16 All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for***

instruction in righteousness: 17 That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.

Brothers and Sisters, we must keep our eyes focused on Jesus Christ and the unadulterated Word of God, not looking to the right or the left, but taking the stand we believe God would have us to take, one of righteousness, godliness and true holiness. We must be bold in our belief of His truths and determine to never compromise our beliefs because of what iniquitous man and his laws may seek to do as they look to have dominion over God also.

Many things are happening now that are very difficult for the truly born again Christian to digest and deal with. Just considering the abortion issues and the recent events revolving around that practice along with the recent addition of the legalization of gay marriage in our nation it is easy also to see how many are becoming distracted, perplexed and troubled about how this will effect the true church of Jesus Christ.

Many are truly and legitimately concerned about how some of these issues will disrupt their ability to minister the Gospel of Jesus Christ in this present world. It seems that far too many have evidently left God and His plan for man in the dust to pursue their own desires and agenda. We too have freedom of speech, so let us use it in the proper spirit to speak God's Word, reproof and instruction in righteousness.

Our government policies, the legal systems and far too many of those professing Christianity have chosen to follow the way of compromise and acceptance. Only the truth of God's Word and the anointing of the Holy Ghost can make a difference this time. Don't look to the arm of flesh (*eg. Politics, government policies, laws*) to make the difference, but rather, look to God to uphold His Word and be willing to be a sanctified and set-apart vessel for the glory of God, even in the midst of this gross darkness that has covered our land! It is truly time to go to heart-felt prayer, not just taking a verbal stand condemning the sins, but also praying and reaching for the lost souls who in their ignorance are selling themselves into eternal destruction for the pleasures of sin.

Luke 19:10 *For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.*

2 Corinthians 4:1-3 *Therefore seeing we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we faint not; 2 But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, nor handling the word of God deceitfully; but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God. 3 But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost:*

2 Corinthians 6:16-18 *And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. 17 Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you, 18 And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty.*

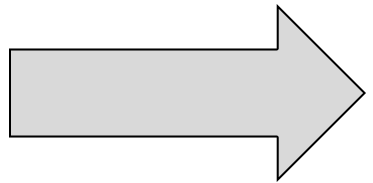

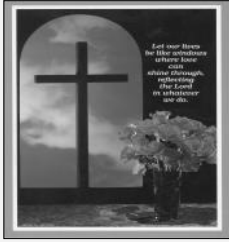
