“General Assembly 2010”

We are quickly approaching spring time again, and with spring comes our annual General Assembly. We wanted to write an article in this issue of The Messenger about this important assembly. Please take the time to read this as it is **very important** to ALL Bible Way ministers, churches, and those in fellowship with us.

Let me first state that while this article will focus a lot on Bible Way churches and ministers, ALL ministers, and churches, and those who receive this Messenger are very much welcomed and encouraged to attend our General Assembly. We will be preaching and teaching on the subject of leadership, which we feel applies to all in some way or another. Leadership is desperately lacking in most people's homes and lives, and even in most churches. We will cover all different levels of leadership and how it pertains to the Body of Christ. We hope that everyone will come be with us in this special and very important assembly. These services will be good for laymen, congregation members, and all, Bible Way members or not, are welcomed to attend. Again, EVERYONE IS WELCOME and we feel will benefit from this **General Assembly to be held April 15-17, 2010.**

I want to begin by talking about the vision of Bible Way Association for just a moment. Because after all everything we do for the Lord begins with a vision. Each of your churches began with a vision.

Proverbs 29:18 Where there is no vision, the people perish: but he that keepeth the law, happy is he.

Bible Way was founded in the heart of Rev. Leslie Buckner over 50 years ago. It started as a vision of a group of ministers walking in like precious faith, joining together in fellowship, and preaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ around the globe. The first letterhead of the Association read at the top, “Trinity” and “Holiness”. Over the years Bible Way and Bro. Buckner have remained faithful to the original vision God gave. Preaching truth and Biblical holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord. (Heb. 12:14)

God has blossomed and expanded the vision into many outreaches and ministries, but all stem from the vision and foundation Bro. Buckner began with so long ago. God also gave Bro. Buckner a vision one day while sitting at his desk in the office. He saw

an old church building, and watched as if dynamite exploded in the church and blew it completely up. When the dust began to settle in this vision, he saw an old wooden wagon wheel spinning where the church had been. In the center of this wagon wheel was written, “Righteousness, Peace, and Joy In the Holy Ghost”. This has been the center core of the ministry of Bro. Buckner, and Bible Way Association.

Romans 14:17 For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.

This message of righteousness, peace, and joy, in the Holy Ghost is at the core of what we believe, preach, and live by in Bible Way Association. It is the last days message, the real message of the kingdom, not what many think the kingdom of God is. You cannot have joy, without peace, and you cannot have peace without righteousness. This is all laid out in a book by Rev. Leslie Buckner called, “The Flood of Righteousness”.

But now let us go on to talk about Bible Way in it's current state. Bro. Buckner also had a vision of thousands of ministers getting full of the seed of righteousness, and then came the rain of righteousness, and then rivers of living water coming out of them to touch the world. Many over the years have wanted to steer Bible Way away from it's original vision, and use it for their own purposes. Praise God they did not succeed. We are still going. But back to these ministers in the vision that had rivers of living water flowing from them. Bible Way is a connecting point for those of like precious faith. The vision of each minister in Bible Way should “fit” into the corporate vision of BWA, and be like minded, and in agreement and unity with the leadership, policies, and doctrine of Bible Way Association. We have worked diligently to see that the Association holds to sound doctrine, and literally keeps things going, “the Bible way”.

Each minister by becoming a member of Bible Way is saying, “I am in agreement with Bible Way's doctrine, beliefs, policies, and practices.” In order to be in agreement with something, you must have a relationship. If God gave the vision for BWA and the vision for each minister in BWA, these should be in agreement because the visions are both of God. They should work together in unison and harmony to accomplish God's plan.

Relationships do NOT work without communication and fellowship. This is part of the reason for the General Assembly of Bible Way Association. Let's consider the definitions of these words:

Relationship

1. a relation between people
2. a state of connectedness between people
3. kinship
4. a significant connection or similarity between two or more things, or the state of being related to something else
5. the connection between two or more people or groups and their involvement with one another, especially as regards the way they behave toward and feel about one another

Notice that a relationship involves connection. This is part of the vision of Bible Way to be a connected group of ministers and churches. Notice also that a relationship means there is involvement between both parties of the relationship. Lastly, notice the word, "kinship". There is no way to mix light and darkness, or oil and water. If we have "THE FAITH" that was once delivered to the saints, we are kinsmen. We are of the household of faith. We are built together to be a habitation of God by His Spirit.

Ephesians 2:19-22 Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellowcitizens with the saints, and of the household of God; (20) And are built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone; (21) In whom all the building fitly framed together groweth unto an holy temple in the Lord: (22) In whom ye also are builded together for an habitation of God through the Spirit.

Now we see then that as members of the Association, we need to view it as a relationship. Relationships require time, effort, loyalty, trust, communication and fellowship and above all the motivating factor has to be LOVE. Our love for God, draws us together. His love in us, draws us together. Our love for souls causes us to unite and help one another fulfill the dreams and visions God has given each of us. What causes relationships to fall apart is when these elements of time, effort, loyalty, trust, communication, and fellowship are neglected.

The plain simple truth is, souls are not being saved today because the Body of Christ is un-relational. We must ALL work to remedy that. Many see that as a shortcoming of Bible Way. We are few at Headquarters, and do try to be involved with each of the ministers on a relational level. We have a prayer list here in our office which we pray over every day

for the needs of our ministers. We provide legal covering and help for the business aspects of running churches. We hold revivals and area meetings to try and facilitate unity and involvement between our ministers and churches. We endeavor to help struggling churches, and have kept many churches open when they would otherwise be closed. Many founders of churches who are gone on to their rewards have entrusted Bible Way with the ministries and churches they have built to see them go on and continue reaching souls, and to protect them from false and dangerous doctrines. We are trying to relate to each of you, our ministers, and be there for you to the best of our ability. Because we are few we cannot be in all places which makes it necessary to have a central gathering or assembly to impart to each other as God's Spirit guides.

Communication

1. The act of imparting, conferring, or delivering, from one to another; as the communication of knowledge, opinions or facts.
2. interchange of knowledge;

One of the ways a relationship thrives and survives is through communication. Notice that communication is the act of imparting. We as leaders of Bible Way Association hope that we can impart into the members, ministers, and churches the words of sound doctrine, and the anointing of the Word to make it alive. Listen, one person cannot do it all. We need ministers in every state, who understand and are in agreement with the vision of the Association, and can communicate that to people God has entrusted to them. See let's look at Jesus' pattern.

He received it from His Father, God.

Then He delivered, or imparted that to 12 men.

Those 12 became 70.

Then 120 gathered in the upper room and received further impartation from Christ, the gift of the Holy Ghost.

They then in turn communicated what they had received to thousands, and were even known as those who turned the world upside down!

Paul instructed Timothy in this principle:

2 Timothy 2:2 And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also.

Communication is the key. Let's take this on a church level. The Pastor is the overseer of that church. God communicates to him the Word of life, instructions, and guidance for that church. Then the pastor must impart, or communicate that vision,

Word, instruction, and guidance to the people of that church, which will empower them to be successful Christians and light and salt in the community.

Now, let's look at the Association in the same principle. God communicated to Bro. Buckner a vision, calling, and ministry to fulfill. God has added other leaders in the Association under Bro. Buckner's oversight to help with communicating and imparting the vision and ministry of Word. During General Assemblies, Camp Meetings, Revivals, Teaching Conferences, ect. The leaders are trying to communicate and impart the vision, direction, and instruction to the body of ministers within the Association. This spiritual communication and impartation of truth, wisdom, knowledge, and understanding then is meant to empower our ministers to take what they have received and communicate it back to the places they minister. One of Bro. Buckner's callings, as we all know well, is to be a minister to ministers.

However, if there is a disconnect between in the lines of communication, there becomes a lack of power to move the body in the direction God wants it to go! This is where the next part of this study comes into effect. FELLOWSHIP!

We are in a time when gathering together is of the utmost importance. Remember we must communicate. In order to communicate effectively there must be true and sincere fellowship.

Hebrews 10:23-25 *Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;) (24) And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: (25) Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.*

The purpose of the General Assembly is a yearly time for the ministers and members of Bible Way Association to gather, communicate, and fellowship in order to keep the relationship between all of us strong.

Amos 3:3 *Can two walk together, except they be agreed?*

The enemy would love nothing more than to keep the precious Body of Christ divided, un-relational, and not communicating, because he is the author of confusion. Spiritual communication ELIMINATES confusion. He would love to keep us all in the "lone ranger" mentality. You know, the one that says, "Me and Jesus got our own thing going...." Well brothers

and sisters, that is exactly what the devil wants. He wants us separated, independent, and "doing our own little thing". Why? Because when we come in agreement and unity the power of God multiplies! If one can chase 1,000 and 2 can put 10,000 to flight, that is a 10X multiplication!

1 Corinthians 3:9 *For we are labourers together with God: ye are God's husbandry, ye are God's building.*

The anointing will flow where brethren are dwelling together in unity. (PS. 133) And we need the anointing today more than anything else. The anointing will accomplish the impossible and it will reach the unreachable! I even feel the mighty presence of God while sitting here typing this. Hallelujah! Glory be to God!

The third definition we need to look at is fellowship. The word fellowship means:

Fellowship

1. Companionship; society; consort; mutual association of persons on equal and friendly terms;
2. Association; confederacy; combination.
3. Partnership; joint interest; as fellowship in pain.
4. Communion; intimate familiarity.

Folks, I hope that you can have an "ear to hear" this today. The Body of Christ thrives on the communication and fellowship of it's members. Likewise, Bible Way Association will thrive on the communication and fellowship of it's members. THIS IS THE MAIN PURPOSE OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL ASSEMBLY!

For several years, I have been involved in getting the Messenger published, and getting letters and advertisements about Bible Way out to the ministers. We all have pleaded and pleaded for our ministers and members to come to the Bible Way functions. We have had some mighty moves of God here at Doniphan, Mo, but I grieve for those who are missing these functions. Not just for the numbers sake, but because I see how that the lack of communication and fellowship is hindering and affecting the work that Bible Way is trying to do.

Remember the song that we sang as children, "If we all will pull together..." There is a greater work to be done through Bible Way Association and all of it's ministers and churches, but it will only happen if we are in TRUE FELLOWSHIP, and if that FELLOWSHIP IS IN CHRIST!. I know that some have legitimate reasoning why you cannot attend, of which we do understand. However, I also know that

there are several full time ministers who do not work a secular job that have not been here in many years and some who have never been here at all. There are others, who live within a hundred mile radius who come to maybe one service out of obligation. Folks, if we want our people in our churches to be faithful, don't you think we need to lead by example? If we preach faithfulness to our congregations, we should be faithful to our Association, it's fellowship, and corporate vision.

Let me make this a little clearer for I already sense some of you rolling your eyes. Bible Way requires that it's ministers attend at least one Camp Meeting per year, and the General Assembly held each year in April. Now it works just like a local church would. You want your people to be there every service, yet you want them to attend and be faithful because they see the importance of it and because it is in their heart to be there, not just out of obligation.

The same goes for us, we want our members and ministers to attend because it is in their heart to be a part of this organization. If we signed up in affiliation and agreement with BWA, it should have been because we felt a drawing and leading of the Lord to do so, and because we were in agreement with it. Therefore, as members of the Association we should retain that feeling and sense of agreement with BWA which can only be done through being connected, involved, and in communication and fellowship.

We all hope and pray Bro. Buckner is around for many, many more years, but just because He is in good health and strong as ever, should we just assume that "the association will take care of it's self". God forbid! We need to take the initiative and follow the lead of Bro. Buckner. He has worked very hard to build Bible Way, but I have heard him say countless times, he did not build it for himself, but to have something to pass on to others. Something that will go on after he is gone. Now, of course none of us knows how much longer till Jesus returns, but we have the command to occupy till he comes. We have the command to go into all the world and teach all nations, we carry that responsibility as ministers of the Gospel. Just as Bro. Buckner has worked tirelessly and selflessly to build Bible Way, shouldn't we the members, not work just as hard both to continue to build and to maintain it and cause it to grow?

You know, I would venture to say that the majority of us in BWA have preached against a lot of the junk that is going on in the so called, "Christian" world today. We have probably complained and spoke against all of the false and fake things we see going on. But it is not enough to be against something, you

also have to be for something. We should be just as passionately for the truth and right ways of the Lord as we are against the false! We should be "for" what God is doing in BWA if we are a part of it, and we should promote and support it.

The great outpouring in Joel Chapter 2, comes after God gives instruction through the prophet Joel to His people:

The instruction included, "gathering the people" and "assembling the elders". Fellowship is partnership, and joint interest. If we are Bible Way, for goodness sake let's be Bible Way! There are those still out there dabbling with people and things they should not be. For you I would say, beware who you fellowship with. Light has no fellowship with darkness! Come out from among them and be separate! Walk in the light as he is in the light and we can have fellowship one with another that will produce a powerful move of God again in the U.S. and even around the world.

So we are in a critical time for the entire world. We must come together, and be perfectly joined together. We must get and keep the mind of Christ, and continue in fellowship.

1 Corinthians 1:9-10 God is faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord. (10) Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.

We are looking forward to great things, because we know we have some of the best ministers and members in this Association, and the main thing is we are holding true to the Word of God. God will honor and bless them that honor His Word.

So, now here is my final point to this entire article. **Please make plans to attend ALL of the services of the General Assembly which is to be held April 15-17, 2010.** Bro. Buckner has been in prayer for this meeting has received the leading of the Lord. We will be preaching and teaching on leadership. This is VERY IMPORTANT to YOUR ministry and church. We have many good preachers, but are we good leaders? This will cover many areas, as everything we are involved with requires some type of leadership. The Association requires leadership. The churches require leadership. Marriages and families require leadership. Even our individual self as a Christian requires leadership. So this General Assembly will be good for everyone, from the

minister to the congregation. Again, EVERYONE IS WELCOMED TO ATTEND, whether they are in Bible Way or not.

Special Statement: Bible Way has not been as stringent and forceful in the required attendance to these meetings as other organizations are. We hope that we do not have to enforce this requirement but that all of our members will see the importance of being involved in the Association, and come of their own desire.

Another point I would like to make briefly, is about the churches affiliated with Bible Way Association. Pastors have the responsibility in a Class 1 and Class 2 church to see that the people of that church understand that they are a membership church of Bible Way Association. In other words, as members of a Bible Way C-1 or C-2 church they are members of Bible Way Association. C-1 and C-2 pastors should enthusiastically and whole heartedly promote Bible Way functions to their church. In the past some members had all kinds of time to go to ladies meetings, TD Jakes, or Joyce Meyers meetings, but never showed up here at Bible Way's functions. Again, if we are holding a Bible Way credential in our wallet, operating under a Bible Way charter, or in a Bible Way church, for goodness sake LET'S BE BIBLE WAY!

We want all of our members and churches to view BWA Camp Meetings as THEIR Camp Meetings. BWA youth camp, as THEIR youth camp. The camp grounds, as THEIR camp grounds, ect....

Instruct your church people often about the importance of the relationship between Headquarters and the members of the Association, and how that we need the communication, fellowship, and ministry because it will impart something to us, and help us be in unity. Also, be a leader by example, and do your very best to support these functions and meetings.

Let me close this article with a scripture:

Ephesians 4:11-16 And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; (12) For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ: (13) Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ: (14) That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive; (15) But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ: (16) From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love.

If we will become fitly joined together, every member will both receive strength and supply strength, and the Body will march on in victory!

I did not write this article to seem harsh or unkind, and I do know that we have a wonderful Association, full of people that love the Lord and want to work for Him. I appreciate all of you who are doing your part to see this Association accomplish the will of the Lord and reach out with the Gospel. We could not be where we are today without the loyal and faithful membership of each of you. Let us each one work together until the return of the Lord, and see mighty things done in the name of Christ Jesus our Lord.

Greetings in the wonderful name of Jesus Christ our Lord!

We hope that you are finding 2010 to be a year of blessings and a year of renewal. There are always challenges to meet, but by the help and grace of God we are more than conquerors!

I feel it very urgent to write you today, concerning The Voice of Truth World Outreach Ministries Division of Bible Way Association.

We are in a trying and perilous time, as we all know. This is a time of severe darkness upon this earth. The adversary is working with lies and deception that is causing this generation to come up full of wickedness, hatred, and much evil imaginations. At times the darkness of the day and time we live in is nearly too much for us to bear. However, we must not lose our purpose as Christians and the Body of Christ. We have a mission from the Lord.

I want to present a thought for all to consider concerning The Voice of Truth World Outreach Ministries Division.

A mission is a special assignment that is given to a person or group. Many have failed to understand that The Voice of Truth is a mission work, and a very important one at that. Today much of the so called "missions and missionaries" are little more than a title used to rake in large sums of money. Many collect funds year round, only to waste it by using the money to fly around to different countries just to preach a service or two, with LITTLE TO NO REAL REVIVAL OR LASTING CHANGE! Please do not take us the wrong way, there are real and legitimate missions works out there, but honestly there are few who really put the funds to good use making an eternal difference for the Kingdom of God.

But really, missions is a broader and more inclusive term than we use it for. Every church, no matter in which country, has a mission. Every true minister of the gospel has a mission to fulfill. The term "missions" or "missionary" is not used in the Bible, but rather we are ALL given this command:

Mark 16:15-20 ***And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. (16) He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. (17) And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; (18) They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. (19) So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God. (20) And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.***

Consider very closely the underlined phrases in the above verse. This is not a limited command to a certain group of people, or to a certain area. This command is to "THEM THAT BELIEVE." furthermore, them that believe are to preach THE Gospel "EVERYWHERE".

I hope that we can re-think the way in which we view "missions". Your church, is a mission. Your ministry is a mission. Evangelism is a mission. And the 5-fold ministry found in Ephesians 4:11 all fall under the definition of the word "mission", which is, "a special assignment given to a person or group."

What does this have to do with The Voice of Truth?

God has given us the assignment to be a voice of truth reaching around the world. That is the vision for this ministry. Sometimes we look at the limitations this ministry faces of finance, labor, equipment, ect, and are amazed at how much we have already been able to do. God has truly blessed this ministry from it's very beginning. Actually, this ministry stems from the personal ministry of Rev. Leslie Buckner, started over 50 years ago. All down through the years God has blessed and enabled this ministry to touch thousands of lives with the message of the truth, and the move of the Spirit.

Today we are faced with a crossroads however in the important mission work to reach out to people with audio, video and printed literature.

Consider the following information:

- From 2008 to 2009 The Voice of Truth's average monthly income dropped 27%. Then, considering 2009's income with the first 2 months of 2010, our income has dropped another 23%. That is a reduction of 50% in 2 years.
- The price of materials and postage has increased drastically as well in the past 2 years.

By no means are we complaining, as we have already said the Lord has proven time and time again His faithfulness and blessing to this ministry. We thank Him for the supporters and partners we do have and their commitment to join in this mission to reach around the globe with the voice of truth.

However, this shortfall of funding does leave us with having to make some tough decisions. We must either cut some of our current outreaches, or find a way to fund them.

God will provide, of this we are sure, however, we feel we must present this need to our many friends, partners, and supporters, and all who partake of this ministry, in hopes that God will speak to hearts to join with us in this important work.

We hear reports all of the time about how people enjoy the CD's, DVD's, cassettes, and literature this ministry puts out. For many the ministry going forth is their lifeline, and we know it is not the will of the Lord to reduce the outreach of this ministry, but rather to increase it.

There are so many avenues to get the ministry out to people today. We want to use as many of them as we can. We are currently on the radio on the Potosi, Mo area, thanks to the support of the Bible Way Gospel Lighthouse of Cadet, Mo. We would love to be back on the radio in more areas, as so many people need to hear the messages God has given Bro. Buckner down through the years.

We are glad to have found the relatively inexpensive avenue of internet outreach. Thanks to several donations we were able to purchase the needed software and are broadcasting a 24/7 Internet Radio Station with preaching and singing. There is much more we could do in this area to expand as well. We hope to provide podcasts, and even video downloads by internet in the future.

Prisons, nursing homes, shut-inns are another way we reach out with the good news of Christ. As well

as monthly mailings to the C-1 and C-2 pastors of Bible Way as yet another way to minister to ministers and keep them encouraged and built up in the faith.

We are truly blessed to have such a place to come each year and keep the revival fires burning in our hearts. Many think that Old Time Holy Ghost Camp Meeting has no place in this modern age, but we see the fruit of what coming together each year with our focus on God and His Word will do. We are committed to the old paths and landmarks that have touched and changed so many lives down through the years.

A “Mission Work” within the United States of America

The spring season is just around the corner. With spring often comes new growth and a sense of excitement. Spring is always wonderful.

Just as spring fills the air with freshness and excitement and prospect of the renewal of life and a time of bringing forth the fruit of the earth, so God's presence should fill our hearts and lives from day to day with new excitement and a sense of refreshing.

Seasonal changes of the earth holds little influence on the matters of men's souls and their relationship with God. However, our hearts need to be renewed and revived constantly with the excitement and possibilities of reaching new souls in the name of Jesus and we should reach for every opportunity of planting the Word of God, the living seed of life, in the good ground of their hearts.

Proverbs 11:30 *The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life; and he that winneth souls is wise.*

Mark 16:15 *And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.*

16:16 *He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.*

As we turn our attention towards the purpose and vision of the great commission which Jesus gave unto the church we must consider the great responsibility of the body of Christ to expend our time, efforts and resources to this end.

Simple observation will tell that far too many pleas for help ends up providing lavish life styles or to build huge corporations with assets that many times do not reach their projected goals or at the very least, it leaves that appearance.

Bible Way Association has a long history of expending its assets for the sake of the churches and ministries that are a part of the Association. While we do not have the ability to carry every load, we reach to our fullest extent possible, and sometimes stretching beyond our ability, in order to provide assistance to affect the survival and growth of our churches.

These are perilous times, not only because of the financial times we are in, but also more importantly, because of the blindness and darkness that is affecting too many lives in our generation due to seducing spirits and the doctrines of devils which the Apostle Paul referred to as he wrote to Timothy. Christians are loosing their concern and compassion for others that are in need, and are focused more on self and their own personal needs or their own little corner. We look around the world and see so many peoples whose lives are being devastated for one reason or another, whether it be natural disaster or because of a lifestyle of sin and wickedness that ravage

their lives and societies in spite of their own best efforts due to a separation from the grace of God. It is certain we should feel compassion for them and their needs. There is no doubt the ravages of sin have dominated their lives and they need help and deliverance, not only with support and caring but, more importantly, with the good news of Jesus Christ and the enlightenment of the way of salvation. All of these things can be readily observed and are understood throughout the world.

What is harder for the Christian community in the United States to see and understand is the ever-present need of individuals around us, who are hungry, homeless, and destitute in our own cities and neighborhoods, by the pitfalls of society and perhaps by their own mistakes or decisions. Therefore we need to look to the combined ability of the Christian body, “the church”, to reach many more through our combined abilities and resources.

Ephesians 4:11 *And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers;*

4:12 *For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ:*

4:13 *Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:*

4:14 *That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive;*

4:15 *But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ:*

4:16 *From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love.*

The church is God's plan to reach the lost and to help supply the needs of those who cannot help themselves through the combined efforts of each member of the body.

The Apostle Paul exhorted the church to make preparation for the ministry to the saints in Macedonia who were in need. The church in Achaia was ready to assist and he was exhorting the church in Corinth to be prepared likewise to help those in need.

Acts 2:42 And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.

2:43 And fear came upon every soul: and many wonders and signs were done by the apostles.

2:44 And all that believed were together, and had all things common;

2:45 And sold their possessions and goods, and parted them to all men, as every man had need.

2:46 And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart,

2:47 Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved.

We had an article in the Messenger a few years ago concerning the "Sisterhood of Churches" which endeavored to represent the relationship of caring and concern the churches need to have for one another.

We have knowledge of several churches who are struggling to keep the doors open, some who could not pay their utilities or other bills for the operation of the church without assistance from someone who cares enough to reach a helping hand in their time of need. Sometimes these needs can be several hundred dollars a month.

Bible Way Association has expended literally tens of thousands of dollars during the year of 2009 just for this purpose. Some churches would not have survived without this assistance and would have closed their doors many months ago. Their vision and desire had not faded, but their hearts were overwhelmed and breaking for the souls they were trying to reach with the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the much needed way of salvation. This burden is all about the souls of men, women and children who must hear the true Word of God that will bring the light of the life of Jesus Christ that could enlighten them unto the only way of salvation. The call and burden of the Pastor is to reach the lost in their community. God placed this burden and call in their hearts and many, many times the only thing that is wanting is the financial ability to survive long enough to win another soul, perhaps one at a time, and build the church and a congregation to stand strong.

Romans 10:13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

10:14 How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher?

10:15 And how shall they preach, except they be sent? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things!

10:16 But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Esaias saith, Lord, who hath believed our report?

10:17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Many churches are very dedicated to reach a hand of help in the time of need to those in their community, but struggle to do so in the balancing act of finances and necessities. The enemy and adversary of our soul wants nothing more than to wear down the desire of Gods people and bring them to the place of giving up. This should not be allowed to happen if we have the ability to provide what is needed to prevent it from happening.

The vision and desire of Bible Way Association is to be a supporting arm to assist these churches and Pastors in their crucial times of necessity and to enable them to stand long enough to reach another soul for the glory of God. However we can not do it alone.

The United States of America is one of the most needy and open mission fields in the world due to the blindness and need in the souls of the lost. So many are dying in a lost condition, without the saving knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. In such a prosperous nation as ours there are still so many needs where we as fellow laborers could make the difference in survival and salvation. Who knows, if the local church could make it through their times of need, perhaps, one more soul could be reached with the life changing power of God unto salvation. It could be someone you know, your son or daughter, or those of your neighbor who may be away from your influence.

What a difference it could make in the local churches in any area of the country if we could feel the needs of our sister churches and catch a part of their vision to fulfill the great commission in their city, the same great commission that we have in our own communities. Remember we are all workers together with God for this same purpose, His great purpose. Let us not become an island and forget the needs of our sister churches in their time of need. One church that we have supported in this manner is now reaching souls and is beginning to see the growth that is so necessary and vital to enable them to continue the ministry in their community. Souls are being won for the glory of God. Fellowship is breaking out among them with enthusiasm and excitement.

We often wait for God to move in supernatural ways to provide the needs of the church, when Jesus taught that their giving would be given back by who? "Men" as they give back into your bosom. God uses people to meet the needs of people. This is the core strength of the ministry of the saints as they have compassion and caring for one another.

Luke 6:38 Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be
