There are many mountains to climb and valleys to cross. As we go into a deeper study of mountain climbing we will find that there are also other things that we must accomplish.

We think of the Mount of God as being the place that God resides or a place that we can meet with God. When we get on the top of the mountain and talk with God we are talking with the One that represents righteousness, godliness and holiness There are different mountains that many Christians must climb during their Christian walk which are: the mountain of decision. the mountain of transition, the mountain of teaching, the mountain of endued with power, the mountain of visions, the mountain of showdown (Elijah had a showdown with the devil on Mount Carmel) and the high mountain.

Isaiah 2:2-4

(2) And it shall come to pass in the last days, that the mountain of the LORD'S house shall be established in the top of the mountains, and shall be exalted above the hills; and all nations shall flow unto it. (3) And

many people shall go and say, Come ye, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the <u>house of the God</u> of Jacob; and he will <u>teach us of his</u> <u>ways</u>, and we will <u>walk in his paths</u>: for out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem. (4) And he shall judge among the nations, and shall rebuke many people: and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more.

Chapter two of Isaiah in verse two is concerning all of the nations. The church will have to rebuke many people. We must go up into the high mountain with God but when we come down we must do the things that God has clearly spoken in our hearts and in the Word of God to do. It is then that we will be brought to a place of total peace. We must walk in God's paths, which are straight. If the path is crooked He will make it straight.

Matthew 8:1-3

(1) When he was come down from the mountain, great multitudes followed him. (2) And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped him, saying, Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean. (3) And Jesus put forth his hand, and touched him, saying, I will; be thou clean. And immediately his leprosy was cleansed. Jesus was a mountain climber. Jesus went up on the mountain and when he came down great multitudes followed Him. People are drawn where the power of God is. Leprosy was the man's mountain but Jesus, with the power He received from God, healed him. When you are up on the mountain you receive power so that you will be able to perform the works of God in the valley.

Luke 6:1213, 17

Jesus went to the mountain to talk to His Father all night. Jesus is no different than you and I, if He prayed to God all night we should get up on a mountain and talk to God for a while. After praving all night Jesus came down and chose the disciples and a multitude of people came to Him. If you want a crowd at church you need to get the power of God moving and they will come. You must then keep the power of God. God wants the church to get back to the miracle working business. When someone comes to church they should be healed.

Luke 18:1 And he spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint; **Ephesians 6:18** *Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;*

Jude 1:20 *But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost,*

God gave the vision for Bible Way that people would come here to receive and then go take what they learned and received to other places. We have had different congregations bring four and five hundred people, including youth, to Bible Way and get full of the power of God and go back and revival would start in every church. However, in a couple of months those revivals would die down because the Pastors did not continue to go up the mountain to pray. We have to get the ministry away from distractions and get them back to praving and the ministers have to get the people back to praying.

The church has been given a lie, which is: everything is a blessing and you do not have to do anything. If you want blessed you need to go to the mountain. You may have to go to the mountain of transfiguration, the mountain that will tell you what to do, or the mountain that will change your life.

Zechariah 4:6 Then he answered and spake unto me, saying, This is the word of the LORD unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the LORD of hosts.

We must get back to the spiritual things of God and get out of the carnal realm. When we first started our Camp Meetings there were times that prayer lasted the entire night. One night for example, the camp was bothered and brought down because of various things so we started a prayer chain at the church that would last all night long. Two people would go in and relieve (allow them to leave) two others every hour.

My time came at 4:00am and when I went in the people that came at 11:00pm through 3:00am were still there. At 7:00am in the morning not a person had left and people were shouting, dancing and the glory of God was all over that place. That is what we need again! Prayer needs to be a place in our lives that it is a joy and not a burden!! There was no more break in the move of the Spirit during that Camp Meeting. People began to be saved and filled with the Holy Ghost.

There are a lot of people that need healing today, spiritually and physically speaking. They can have it but they have to pay a price. We must go up into the mountain of God, let Him teach us His ways and then walk in His paths.

Matthew 16:15 He saith unto them, But whom say ye that I am? 16 And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God.

Peter had just had a great spiritual experience. The church has come to the place where they think if God ever blesses you in a service you will never miss God again. Some preachers preach outstanding messages and then think that they will always preach outstanding messages, but they must continue to go to the mountain if they want to do it again.

Hebrews 1:2 Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds;

1 John 5:4-5

(4) For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith. (5) <u>Who is he that</u> <u>overcometh the world, but he that</u> <u>believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?</u>

Romans 8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.

Romans 8:19 For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation of the sons of God.

We must believe that Jesus is the Son of God. Some of the modern day churches do not believe that and they have taken out the virgin birth. When we believe that Jesus is the Son of God we can believe that we are the sons of God. If we are the sons of God He has imparted Himself and His power to us that we might work the works of God. The people wait for the manifestation of the sons of God but unless we take the trip to the mountain with God just like the Son of God did it will never happen.

We go up to the mountain as the sons of God. We cannot be sons of God unless we have righteousness, godliness and holiness. You may think, "Well, I am a Christian." Moses told Joshua that he could not go up into the mountain with him. Jesus told his disciples to stay while He went and prayed in the garden.

That was done away with when Jesus died on the cross and the veil was rent in two. We now have access unto the Father. He is my Father just as He was Jesus Father, but I am an adopted son. We are not the Son of God but we are the adopted sons of God and joint heirs with Jesus Christ. We have to pay the price as Jesus did, we must die. **Therefore if any man be** in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new (2 Corinthians 5:17).

Someone may tell you that another person has died by saying they have passed away or they are gone. When you look at the body it looks like it is still there but what they are trying to say is that the real him is gone, the old man has passed away and that he is in a new heaven. Our old carnal man has to pass away and the only way to do that is according to Romans 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ve present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. (2) And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

According to **1 John 5:5** the people that believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God are the people that will overcome the world. In some of the new translations of the Bible they do away with the blood and the virgin birth and when they do away with the virgin birth, Jesus cannot be the Son of God. We must overcome the world just as Jesus did and the way we do it is by believing that Jesus is the Son of God and that through His blood we have the right to become the sons of God.

I have been on several different mountains during the past forty years. I am now on the mountain of transition. God has instructed me in a lot of different ways. When you go up on the mountain you must pay attention to God and when you come down it is imperative that you walk therein. **Psalms 1:1-4** Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. (2) But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. (3) And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper. (4) The ungodly are not so: but are like the chaff which the wind driveth away.

Some people say that it is so easy to serve God and walk in victory. It is easy, while you are in Camp Meeting getting blessed but when you come down you must work. The ministry is in the valley. The sons of God are going to have to come down to deliver the goods to those in the valley, to the poor, blind, crippled and all those that are in need. We have to pay a price to be able to do that, which is to pray and meditate on the laws of the Lord day and night. When we do that the devil cannot keep us from prospering because we are like a tree planted by the water

The ungodly will not produce fruit. We allow many things to take up our time that we should be using to spend with the Lord. Some have confessed they spend too much time on the computer and going to visit other people. It is time that we go to the mountain away from everyone else and visit with God. There is probably nobody that loves to be around people like I do. But the fact is I cannot go visit everyone because I cannot minister to anyone until I have spent time with God. We need to put ourselves in a position that we can be on a higher plane and come down and minister when needed

Matthew 17:1-2 (1) And after six days Jesus taketh Peter, James, and John his brother, and bringeth them up into an high mountain apart, (2) And was transfigured before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light.

Jesus took three people apart to the high mountain. In **chapter six of Luke** He took all twelve disciples but in **Matthew 17:1** Jesus takes only three. They were not just His "picks," He was not partial to them. I can almost hear the gossip, "Look, Jesus is partial to Peter, James and John." These were men that would someday set in control the church in Jerusalem. They would someday lay hands on the sick, cast out devils and win souls.

Jesus took Peter, James and John in a high mountain apart so that He could teach them something. They were neither with the other nine apostles nor with the crowd of people. We need some high mountains apart from everyone else. Jesus was transformed before them and His face did shine as the sun and His raiment was white as the light.

Malachi 4:2 But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall

Luke 16:16 The law and the prophets were until John: since that time the kingdom of God is preached, and every man <u>presseth</u> into it.

Romans 14:17 For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.

You must press into the kingdom of God. Jesus was transfigured before the prophets; He showed them who He

was. Moses and Elias appeared and talked with them.

Peter is a typical man in the Bible to study because he fits nearly every one of us. He was always upset. He would chop an ear off at the drop of a hat. He asked Jesus if he should call down fire and consume the people. In **Matthew 16:23** Jesus **said unto Peter**, **Get thee behind** me, Satan: thou art an offence unto me: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men, because Peter still had a lot to learn. Peter did not believe that he would ever deny Jesus but scripture tells us that he did. When Peter was pressed a little he threw a cussing fit.

When Peter went to Jerusalem and prayed in the upper room and was endued with power from on high he changed. Peter went on a high mountain apart to pray and came out ready to preach a message that led three thousand people to give their hearts to the Lord. God will do something for the people that are willing to pay a price!

Matthew 17:4 Then answered Peter, and said unto Jesus, Lord, it is good for us to be here: if thou wilt, let us make here three tabernacles; one for thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias.

The reason there is so many different denominations today is because they have made a church for Moses, one for Elias and one for someone else. There is just one Lord, one faith, and one baptism by one Spirit. There is only one Lord, who is Jesus Christ, and we must believe that He is the Son of God. When you pray you pray to the Father in the name of Jesus.

We need to go to a high mountain apart, a place that we can really believe

that Jesus is the Son of God. The natural man has a hard time believing that a virgin conceived and bore a Son of God. That is the reason that there is junk on the television that tries to state that Jesus married Mary Magdalene. some try to state that Jesus is not the Son of God but merely a Prophet. I want to declare boldly that He is the Son of the living God and whoever come to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder to those that diligently seek him (**Hebrews 11:6**).

Some people will get up directly after they have been blessed by God and tell you what they do not believe. Most denominations are built on what they do not believe in, such as: speaking in tongues, shouting, miracles, healings and falling on the floor. Some people say that they do not believe in emotionalism but I want to feel what I have. I want to release what God has given me to others.

Mathew 17:5-8 While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him. (6) And when the disciples heard it, they fell on their face, and were sore afraid. (7) And Jesus came and touched them, and said, Arise, and be not afraid. (8) And when they had lifted up their eyes, they saw no man, save Jesus only.

When God spoke that Jesus was His Son and that we needed to listen to Him a transition took place. The law and the Prophets took a back seat and Jesus stepped up front. The three men that witnessed this were going to be the elders of the church at Jerusalem. James became the Pastor and Peter and John became the Apostles. We need the return of the Apostles and the Prophets in the church today.

We need some power packed preachers that will step out as the Apostles did in the doctrine, fellowship, breaking bread and in prayers. God will then add to the church daily such as should be saved but there is going to have to be a price paid. To many people are trying to step out on the price that another preacher has paid and all they are doing is messing things up. Our hearts have to be in whatever we are doing.

You may hear a preacher preach the gospel but many times people do not believe it until they have a personal experience with God. I was raised in a family that really did not believe in anything and for certain did not believe in Pentecost. Some of my family were good people and some were not. Some of them took pride in troubling Pentecost preachers. God chose to save a Buckner and use him to reach out to them. The preaching of the truth brought a lot of my family together. Some were healed, saved and delivered. They had to believe that Jesus is the Son of God.

Joel 2:16 Gather the people, sanctify the congregation, assemble the elders, gather the children, and those that suck the breasts: let the bridegroom go forth of his chamber, and the bride out of her closet.

We should address the Word of God and the Spirit as He. The Spirit dwells in our Spirit man. The main part of a person is their soul. The bride must come out of the closet. Your mind is your closet. If your closet is full of junk then clean it out by the renewing of your mind.

The bridegroom must come out of the chamber. The chamber represents the heart. When the groom comes out of the chamber and the bride out of the closet you will have revival because your mind, soul and spirit agree together. Then you will be able to present your body a living sacrifice. holy and acceptable unto God (Romans 12:1). You will be renewed, old things are passed away; behold, things are become new (2 all Corinthians 5:17). You will be free by the power of the Holy Ghost and become a son of God

I went to a couple's house, of which the world would call rough folks, to invite them to church. The man was on his roof working and the woman was chewing tobacco and peeling peaches. I invited them to church and the man said, "God had been dealing with me to go to that church. I will be there next Sunday." I asked the woman if she would go with him, she spit her chew out and said, "I reckon I will go if he does." You could have knocked me over with a feather.

A week from Sunday they pulled up with their old car, of which had it's fenders were tied up with bailing wire. You could see surprised faces as they were seen driving up. We sang two songs and the Holy Ghost got a hold of that couple and they ran to the altar and got gloriously saved. A few weeks later we had a baptismal service. The man came to me and explained that he could not get baptized because he had something to do first.

When the power of God moved the man got up and put his hand on another gentleman's shoulder, of who was a turkey farmer. They talked for a bit and then he ran down the isle and said, "I can get baptized now." After the service I asked the turkey farmer what he said to him. The turkey farmer said, "He told me that he has been stealing and eating my turkeys for five years. I told him that I forgave him." That is exactly what the church needs today forgiveness, restoration, reconciliation and restitution.

There may be some little thing that is keeping you from getting up on the mountain. You may need to forgive vourself. One man stated the fact that he could not enter in and worship at church was because every time he would try he would picture a log chain in his mind. He finally remembered a time that he stole a log chain out of someone's truck. He could not get the victory in his life until he bought that person another log chain. He stated that log chains are expensive but it was worth the cost to get the victory.

There are people in the church that need to forgive one another and stop gossiping about one another. But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses (Mark 11:26). Jesus is the Son of God and He forgave us of our sins and we should forgive others. There is no guilt when a person has been forgiven.

hope to have the baseball diamond completed and more activities in place.



To my dear friends at Bible Way Association.

In the early morning of May 15th I could not get my breath and collapsed on the floor. My wife, Melody, called 911. The paramedics gave me CPR and brought me back. But during the helicopter flight to the hospital they lost me again. However with CPR they were able to bring me back a second time. But by the time I got to the hospital they lost me a third time and nothing they did helped me.

The hospital Chaplain was actually starting to fill out my death certificate when all of a sudden my heart started to beat again. Isn't that just like the Lord? They packed me in ice, put me on a ventilator and put me in a drug induced coma for two days. The doctor said I would have brain damage and organ damage in several areas due to the lack of oxygen.

So here's the other part of this miracle. When I came out of the coma, my brain was fine. I have no memory of the event and maybe a couple weeks before. My kidneys took a beating but they are back to working fine. I did undergo an implant of a pacemaker/ defibrillator.

The night before I was finally discharged, I was begging the Lord to let me go home, I couldn't take one more day in the confines of a hospital room. And suddenly the Lord reminded me of how much more we should all desire to be in our heavenly home with Him. That is what we all really long for, isn't it?

Who knows what good things could be just ahead if the Lords will is given a chance to bring forth the good fruit of his purpose and will.


<u>YOUTH LITERATURE</u> <u>Another new volume</u> <u>coming in September!</u>


