

# The History Of Bible Way Association

### Born Of a Vision

Many times new churches are started as the result of disagreements and splits in existing churches. One side will stay and the other side will move off and start another church. Bible Way Association did not start as a split from any other church or organization. Leslie Buckner had only been saved for a few months when he knew God had called him to minister the Gospel of Jesus Christ.



In July of 1958 Rev. Leslie Buckner and his entire family organized a prayer meeting in their home in which the children and several people gave their hearts to the Lord.

By October of 1958 they became established as a church under the name of Community Fellowship Pentecost Church.

It soon became very evident that the hand of God was upon this little group as it began to grow until it became too big for a living room and so they located a little building where a church had been on 18<sup>th</sup> and Geyer in St. Louis, MO that was vacant at that time. This building would seat close to 100 people and the church outgrew it within six months.

From that point many people were being saved and rededicating their life to Jesus and they searched for a larger building and found an empty drug store that was located at 12<sup>th</sup> and Sydney. Before long it became necessary to move again and find another building that could accommodate the growing crowd. They located an old Presbyterian Church at 1614 Menard that would seat over 400 people that could be rented. The previous church had just built a new church building and moved to their new location. During that two year period of growth God had added 633 people who were saved or renewed in their walk with God. This was a glorious time of revival.

Within the first year, and after much prayer of the Founders, the decision was made to start an organization.



During April of 1959 the Community Fellowship Pentecost Church became an unincorporated association of ministers and churches having adopted the organizational name of Community Fellowship Pentecost Ministers and Churches Association.

In 1960 the Board of Directors of Community Fellowship Pentecost Ministers and Churches Association decided to hire an attorney to petition the court for this organization to become a body politic and corporate by Pro Forma Decree of Incorporation in the State of Missouri.

The case was heard on July 7, 1960 by Judge Waldo C. Mayfield and the decree was issued making Community Fellowship Pentecost Ministers and Churches Association a body politic and body Corporate under Chapter 352 of the Missouri Statutes.

God began to lead Rev. Buckner to reach out beyond the church with revival services and it soon became evident and confirmed that this was the direction God wanted him to pursue. In 1962 they began to minister revival services in the south central part of Missouri and moved to Winona by early 1963. During the next several years revival sprang forth across the State of Missouri with hundreds of souls being saved and filled with the Holy Ghost. God moved mightily and blessed the ministry.

In 1965 Rev. Buckner held a revival at the church in Doniphan were the Camp Grounds are currently locat-

ed. This time of revival packed the church and the opportunity soon presented itself to purchase the church and parsonage. After much prayer and confirmation from the Lord the decision was made to acquire the property.

In the year of 1965 a meeting was held in Poplar Bluff Missouri by the Board of Directors and the Founders of the Community Fellowship Pentecost Ministers and Churches Association. It was resolved at this meeting to move the central location of this organization from St. Louis Missouri to Ripley County Missouri. The petition was made and the decree issued and recorded on April 29, 1966 by the presiding Judge, Howard R. Maness in the Riplev County Courthouse in Doniphan Missouri which placed the Headquarters and central office of the Association in Doniphan Missouri. Over the years, at the leading of the Lord, the Association was able to acquire the properties that it currently owns where the Headquarters and Camp Grounds are located.

During the early part of 1974 the decision was made by the Board of Directors to change the name of the organization from Community Fellowship Pentecost Ministers and Churches Association to the name which it currently bears, Bible Way Association. This decree was issued on May 7, 1974 by Judge Rex Hinson and filed and recorded June 18, 1974 at the Ripley County Courthouse in Doniphan, Missouri.

On June 23, 1992 the final petition was filed which would bring the Association to our present standing as an organization while maintaining its original integrity and validity. On July 7, 1992 the decree was issued by Judge Arthur Cope and was filed and recorded on August 3, 1992. This decree established the current Articles of Incorporation upon which Bible Way Association stands.



Through the years since the beginning vision and efforts Bible Way Association has not only provided valuable coverage for hundreds of churches but the power of the ministry and its anointing has influenced and touched literally thousands of souls with the anointing of the Gospel. At time literally hundreds of souls were added to the Kingdom of God during various revivals and meetings. Camp Meetings are always a highlight with



souls being saved, healed, delivered and forever changed as God ministers into their lives.

Youth Camp Meetings have produced many ministers that are still reaching the lost for Jesus today.



The Association has fostered the beginnings of hundreds of churches across the land and in other nations as well as founding and starting many churches through the years. While some have not survived the years others have prospered and are still ministering to souls in their communities today.



The ministry of Bible Way Association has also reached into foreign lands where churches have been and souls have been saved under this ministry and as a direct result of this anointing and efforts.



We feel that the history of Bible Way Association cannot be adequately described in a single article. Since God ordained and designed this Association

in the beginning the vision has been the central factor that has kept it in line with Gods will.

Through the years there have been many efforts to change one part or another and take the Association in different directions according to the incoming theme of the day. However, we have observed the leadership of Brother Buckner which has always led it back to the original vision that God gave him to walk by.

This vision has been one focused on spreading the Gospel of Jesus Christ around the world. The Gospel that was planted in his heart has not changed through the years to become aligned with the changing tides and seasons as so many ministries have. It must be recognized that even as God never changes so His Word never changes. The message never changes from that which glorifies God rather than man. The true message always glorifies God through Jesus Christ and the anointing of the Holy Ghost.

The vision which God gave started with that purpose and is still the driving force in Brother Buckner's ministry today. It has been observed that the messages which Brother Buckner delivers have not changed over the vears, they have only grown deeper towards leading souls into the foundation of Christ and the establishment of the Kingdom of God within, which is righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Ghost according to Romans chapter 14:17. God has led this ministry through the Word of God and prayer and He continues to do so.

Another part of the vision which prompted Brother Buckner to establish the Association in Doniphan Missouri was directed to building a place where ministers and congregations could come together to receive of the Lord under the anointing of the Holy Ghost and take the power and blessing of the Holy Ghost back to their churches.

In time the Camp Grounds work had begun. This was a part of the vision, but, through the years others began to participate in the work of this ministry that had for so long been carried on the shoulders of Brother Buckner. In the early 1970s Brother Buckner tackled building the open air tabernacle that served for camp meetings for over 37 years. Much of this labor was accomplished by Brother Buckner personally. People began to get into the vision and help build the buildings which we enjoy today.



In September of 1997 we enjoyed our first Family Camp Meeting service in the new Sanctuary. This building was built by the generous offerings and labor of those who got behind the vision of the Camp Grounds.



Then again we opened the new Dormitory in 2003 which has been a great asset to both the Youth Camp and the Family Camp. We are honoring Brother Buckner with this issue of the Messenger for his 55 years of tireless service to the Lord. It is our heart-felt belief that God still has great things in store for Brother and Sister Buckner as well as Bible Way Association.

Not only are the activities for the Youth Camp improving but the spiritual achievements are exciting to say the least.



As with any achievement it begins with a vision such as that which God gave to Brother Buckner. Everything from that point has become a reality first of all because it is Gods will.



Along with the vision it also takes two other things to make it happen. The first thing is the commitment and determination of those who attach themselves to the vision. Secondly it takes all of those who have a mind to work to become a part of the vision from that point on. In years past many faithful supporters and helpers understood the importance of this vision and partnered with the ministry of the Association to build it to what it is today.

Many of that generation of givers and supporters have passed unto their reward, but the labors still continue today as new churches, ministers and congregations pick up the mantle to see God's will accomplished.

I am reminded of Nehemiah when he heard of the plight of the remnant of Gods people in Jerusalem he wept, fasted and prayed for Gods intervention. The answer came when the King allowed him to return to Jerusalem with his blessing and authority to revive and rebuild the great city.

In Nehemiah 2:18 he told his brethren that the hand of God was good upon him and the people strengthened their hand to the work.

Each man and family took their share and built the wall and gates that were next to them.

Nehemiah's prayers were answered because the people had a mind to work as stated in Nehemiah 4:6.

We believe it is time to get back to the vision that God has ordained. Bible Way Association and the Camp Grounds are ordained of God to be fruitful and to prosper, if the people have a mind to work.

The Lord is coming soon, this is evident. We must be about our Father's work while it is still day that every possible soul may be reached.

If once again the people of God could recognize the God given vision and God's will to see this vision prosper just imagine what could transpire.

We should all pray for God's will and our part in building the wall once again. The following is an excerpt of a newspaper article taken from "The Sullivan Independent News" which was submitted by the Pea Ridge Holiness Church near Sullivan Mo.



## Local Church Honors Pastor Rev. Leslie Buckner For 55 Years Of Service

In the Pea Ridge Holiness Church, a small country church, located in Pea Ridge, MO, 7 miles south of Sullivan, MO on Mo 185 Highway, just past Meramec State Park honored Rev. Leslie Buckner for his service to God and pastoring for over 55 years. Rev. Buckner, in October 1958, established his first church under the name of

Community Fellowship Pentecost Church. Since that time Bible Way Association has grown and included many churches nationwide and in foreign lands, including Mexico, Philippines, Guatemala and Africa. Some are owned by the Association and many more are associated through charters and certification of pastors through the educational process of Bible Way Association located in Doniphan, Mo.

Early in the year of 1965 Rev. Buckner held a very successful revival at a church in Doniphan, MO. This time of revival packed the church and the opportunity soon presented itself to purchase the church and parsonage. The decision was made to acquire the property.

Later in the year 1965, Rev. Buckner and the Board of Directors and the Founders of the Association resolved to move the central location of this organization from St. Louis, Mo to Ripley County, Mo which placed the Headquarters and the central office of the Association in Doniphan, MO. Rev. Buckner held his first Camp Meeting in 1965 at the camp grounds in Doniphan.

Over the years the Association was able to acquire the additional properties that it currently owns, where the Headquarters, dorms, and campgrounds are located. Family Camps, Youth Camps and other revivals have been, and are continuing to be, held there and people come from all over the country to fellowship.

Rev. Buckner, along with his wife Margaret, which is a big part of his music and ministry, travel throughout the country still at 86 years of age, holding revivals and pastoring churches. His latest pastoring was at Pea Ridge Church, twice for extended periods over the past four years. He is leaving Pea Ridge Holiness Church for other duties in Bible Way association and to continue his great outreach ministry.

His dedication to God and his ministry was marked with a ceremony at the church on Friday evening May 3rd. It was a wonderful celebration of a man who has dedicated his life's work to all the small town and country churches he has helped organize and serve over the years. Rev. Leslie Buckner had a vision to reach around the world with the Gospel message that brings salvation, healing, and restoration and he is certainly accomplishing that vision.

Present at the event on Friday included more that 30 ministers that Rev. Buckner mentored through the Bible Way Association, which represents only a small percent of the pastors he has influenced through the years. Rev. Buckner also travels and preachers to churches and other organizations across the country.

Guests included Pastor Elton Harris, who was the first Secretary and treasurer of Bible Way Association in 1964 and is still with the organization; Pastor Gene Rauls, the very first youth leader in 1965; and Rev. Eugene Abrams, who is the current Secretary and Assistant General Overseer and has been working with Bible Way Association since 1995.

Rev. Buckner has an honorary Doctor of Theology from International Bible Collegiate Seminary in Houston, TX.


