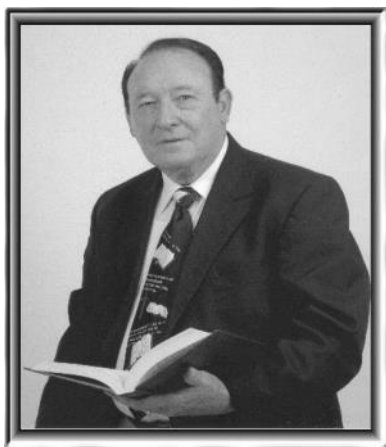

Contentment With Godliness

Zechariah 4:6 *Not by might, nor by power, but by my Spirit, saith Jehovah of hosts.*

Acts 10:38 *How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.*

You know when your are anointed of the Holy Ghost you are going to do good. There are a lot of people that need to do some good.

I have been in the ministry over 56 years and I have had four major visions. I had a vision when I came here, but I'm talking about visions that were just spelled out.

A few weeks ago, God began to open up one of those vision to me. You need to understand that God can hide things from you until the time is right, He just gives you enough of it to make you hungry and to make you search, we need to search the scripture. The Bible tells us in **John 5:39** *Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me.*

Our theme of this camp meeting is "Godliness With Contentment Is Great Gain." I know a lot of people that are not content enough to be godly, and I know a lot that can't be godly because they don't have any contentment. Have you ever noticed how many people there are that are not content with anything. They just have to be doing this or that, they just have to be doing stuff. They could be content, if they would just get down and study, pray and seek God, if they would just get full of the power of God it would make them content. But people are just running to and fro, the Bible teaches about this, and they have no contentment in their life what so ever. I want you to notice that it is godliness with contentment, these two things together.

If you are looking for a place to skip, hop and jump you had it while ago, it was time for it then, but now its time for the word of God.

Matthew 24:35 *Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away.*

1 Timothy 6:1 *Let as many servants as are under the yoke count their own masters worthy of all honour, that the name of God and his doctrine be not blasphemed. 2 And they that have believing masters, let them not despise them, because they are brethren; but rather do them service, because they are faithful and beloved, partakers of the benefit. These things teach and exhort.*

Paul tells us here this has to be taught and exhorted.

1 Timothy 6:3 *If any man teach otherwise, and consent not to wholesome words, even the words of our Lord Jesus Christ, and to the doctrine which is according to godliness;*

I rarely hear godliness or contentment being preached on any more. In fact I don't believe I have ever really heard a message on contentment. How many people do you know, including yourself, that are truly content? In other words, are you content with your pastor, is your pastor content with you, are you content with your church or with your community? Then you can ask yourself are you content with your home, are you content with your wife or your husband? There are a whole lot of things we need to be content with and we can get all that with one shot, and that is godliness with contentment is great gain.

Paul said, don't think about those things that are gain as godliness, that is what people think today. I heard one preacher say, "When they drive by my house, I drive a Rolls Royce, and they know that I am a godly man or I wouldn't be driving a Rolls Royce." I tell you what, that has nothing to do with a Rolls Royce, there are a lot of Rolls Royce drivers that are going to be in hell just like anybody else. It doesn't make any difference what kind of car you drive. Content, some of you know I drove an old Renault around all over this country, and I preached here and preached there, and I was just as contented then as I am now.

We have to get back to being contented, and every time that we see something that we are discontented about we need to try to do something about that with who ever that it involves until we get back to contentment.

The Sunday School teacher taught on that the other day, fellowship. Fellowship means two or more people that are in unity of the Spirit, and having fellowship with God first and then

you can have fellowship with each other. Anytime something bothers me and I am not content about it, I am going to do something about it. I won't live the life a lot of people do, they are discontented, every time you see them they have a new discontentment. "I don't like that, I don't like this, I don't like them." Discontentment has nothing to do with godliness. Let's define godliness just a little bit.

Psalms 1:1 *Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly*

There are people who are walking in ungodly counsel, "Oh rock music is alright in the church," I tell you there is no contentment in it. Everywhere you go anymore you have some kind of music that is not godly, and everybody is on edge, it has to do with things we should be content with and that are not content in our life. Maybe you are not contented with me, well we will fix that after service, because I love you and the reason I love you is because I will tell you the truth. John says you shall know the truth and the truth shall make you free. We should want to be free, a free person is content, I know just a few people that are in jail and they are not content in there. I can tell you of two or three right now, I worked with them for two or three years trying to get them to straighten up their life and they are now in the jail house and they are probably facing federal charges and they are not content in there, they are wanting out bad and they want me to help them out. I cant help them out, I tried to help them when they were out. Now they want something, there are people that wait till it gets to the very end, the worse, then they want something.

Let's look back at our scriptures, **I Timothy 6:3** *If any man teach otherwise, and consent not to wholesome words, even the words of our Lord Jesus Christ, and to the doctrine which is according to godliness;*

We need to go back to the book of Psalms and define godliness first.

Psalms 1:1 *Blessed is the man (how many wants to be blessed?) that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly*

If somebody comes to you and they are not content with their own life they are going to get you upset too, so you can be upset with them, then there will be two that are discontent, and after while they choose up sides and say who is on our side. I will tell you who is on their side, the discontented ones, them. The us are the ones that have been filled with the Holy Ghost and are content with their experience with God. I like to surround myself with people that are content in things and not set around with a people that are of a grouchy spirit all day long, but a contented spirit. That will rub off on you and when you get two of those kind of people and they agree it is going to come to pass, the Bible tells us if two are three agree and it comes to pass it is because they agreed in the name of the Lord, not just two or three people getting together and says lets do it.

Psalms 1:1 *Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.*

The scornful are discontented, how dare a Christian filled with the Holy Ghost, to just sit around and talk to somebody that is discontented all day long and let it rub off on them.

They need that trip thru **Romans 12:1** *I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. 2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.*

Then you and your friends will be content around each other.

It goes on to say **Psalms 1:3** *his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.*

All you have to do is just walk with God and be content. God is walking through this place right now, over the years I have seen all kinds of things happen here. I have seen people jump up and get healed and run, I have seen the time when God said, "Just raise your hand," and I raised my hand and the biggest part of the people fell under the power of God or take off shouting and running. Those kinds of things don't bring contentment they bring a shot of joy for a while, but contentment means that you keep content and the joy. The kingdom of God will keep you content.

Romans 14:17 *For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.*

It is always in the Holy Ghost, but there are many people who resist the Holy Ghost. Some of them say, "Well I don't know if I want to get it or not, I'm afraid of how I will act if I get it." Well you can ask me and this brother how we acted. They tell me he rolled all over, under every pew, when he received the Holy Ghost. People do some wild things when they receive

the Holy Ghost, but they are content.

Psalms 1:3 *And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.*

I want to leave you with this thought as we move along with this, that thought is contentment brings producing. The reason the church is not producing is because they are not content. They run here and they run there, just the other day we talked to somebody who had been to four churches and all four of them weren't to suite them, well if they are so awful mighty they should show up there and help get the thing contented. There are places to work, church, we are not suppose to sit and do nothing. God doesn't want to give it to us on a silver tray, its not something we just get, we need to get out there and work for the things we get. There are many people who think all they have to do is come into Church, just at Church time and leave just as quick as it gets out and run here and run there and run some place else, that is not contentment and that is not being lead of the spirit. Scripture plainly tells us in **Romans 8:14** *For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.*

Let us turn to the book of Romans.

Romans 8:1 *There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. 2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death. 3 For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh: 4 That the righteousness of the law might be ful-*

filled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. 5 For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit. 6 For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

I am telling you the kingdom that is in you is righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Ghost and if that doesn't bring contentment, Church, I don't what to tell you that will bring contentment. Because it involves the Father, the Word and the Holy Ghost.

It tells us in **I Timothy** of the people that are not heeding to doctrine according to godliness.

I Timothy 6:4 *He is proud, (you know pride goeth before a fall and a haughty spirit before destruction) knowing nothing,*

That's rough, Paul said it I didn't, they don't know anything. The do nothings and know nothings will set around and teach everybody else to know nothing and do nothing. They are good teachers, they can get you to set around and not think about godliness, and not think about the power of God, not to think about your friend that's lost, not thinking about the Church. We need to get our mind upon the church, the people in the church and the building.

One of those visions that God gave me several years ago, I just got the full meaning of it a few weeks ago. It involves a whole ship load of people, the ship represents Bible Way and the people represents the people that are in Bible Way or come to Bible Way. It also involves the five fold ministries in the church according to **Ephesians 4 :11** *And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists;*

and some, pastors and teachers; **12** For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ.

These ministries are to help make you godly and content.

1 Timothy 6:4 *He is proud, knowing nothing, but doting about questions and strifes of words, whereof cometh envy, strife, railings, evil surmisings, 5 Perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of the truth*

John said in **John 8:32** *And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.* Jesus said in **John 14:6** *Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.*

There isn't any way to get there but by him, you have to go through him to get to the Father, to get to godliness.

1 Timothy 6:5 *and destitute of the truth, supposing that gain is godliness: from such withdraw thyself.*

We could preach all night on that and I have preached my lungs out for years and years and some people still don't have it, and the reason they don't have it is because they don't want it, they want what is talked about in 1 Timothy chapter six.

1 Timothy 6:5 *Perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of the truth, supposing that gain is godliness: from such withdraw thyself.*

They want to think that gain is godliness, well I would rather be prosperous the right way. *I would that you that you prosper*, the scripture says, *and be in health even as your soul prosperous.* But if your soul is not prospering you are not prosperous even if your driving a rolls Royce or if your living in a million dollar house.

1 Thessalonians 5:23 *and I pray God your whole spirit and soul*

and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

People are missing the whole boat, they are missing it all just to say "I'm prosperous, look at me", "Look here at what I have, it's brand new." No, show me the power of God, that is what we need.

1 Timothy 6:5 *Perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of the truth, supposing that gain is godliness: from such withdraw thyself. 6 But godliness with contentment is great gain.*

Somebody said, "But, you don't know my situation, if you just knew my situation then you would know more about this." So lets turn our Bibles to Philippians chapter 4 and Paul gets down to business about the situation.

Philippians 4:9 *Those things, which ye have both learned, and received, and heard, and seen in me do.*

He also said in another scripture, **1 Corinthians 11:1** *Be ye followers of me, even as I also am of Christ.* In other words don't follow me if I am not following Christ.

Philippians 4:9 says to do, that's the thing people don't like, that word do. You know I have a habit here lately to take one word and can preach an hour. The word do, boy you could preach on that.

Matthew 7:24 says *Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock: 25 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a rock.*

This house stood because they heard and did, established on the rock it could not be shaken, it was godly, it

was content in the storm. Is your experience content in the storm or do you have to pray through in the storm?

Contentment, godliness with contentment is great gain, it covers the whole thing. You have to be godly to have contentment and you have to be content to be godly.

When you hear somebody moaning and groaning and carrying on tell them they need to be content. Lets go a little further here, look back to **Philippians 4:9** *Those things, which ye have both learned, and received, and heard, and seen in me, do: and the God of peace shall be with you. 10 But I rejoiced in the Lord greatly, that now at the last your care of me hath flourished again*

They had neglected Paul's needs. The church today is neglecting the needs of the church and the ministry. Some body said, "Well I'm not going to give my money to that preacher." No you are not just giving to that preacher, you are giving it to the Lord. The preacher just gets it and puts it in the store house like it is suppose to be. Paul said, "I'm so glad now that your care of me has flourished again."

I guess they became discontent with him and quit paying their tithes. That is the way it usually goes. I can tell a discontented person by looking at the church records, and we look at church records all the time, Bible Way records, when the first one becomes discontented you will note the first thing they do is quit paying their tithes, "We'll starve him out." Come on laugh but its true, "We'll get rid of him, we'll just starve him out."

Philippians 4:10 *flourished again; wherein ye were also careful, but ye lacked opportunity. 11 Not that I speak in respect of want: for I have*

learned

That word learned is also used in **Matthew 11:28** *Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me*

If you are yoked up with him you are going to learn something, because if you can't carry your own he will drag you through. When they used to have mule teams going across the country, once in a while they would have an old balky mule that wouldn't pull his load. They would put him right up next to the wagon and the other four or five mules would pull him if he didn't pull his weight. Finally he would tire of being ragged around and get up and start pulling. That is a rough way to learn it but you are going to have to get it one way or another, even if you have to be drug down.

Philippians 4:11 *Not that I speak in respect of want: for I have learned, (now listened to what he learned) in whatsoever state I am, therewith to be content.*

He said, "I had to learn that." He had to go through some hard things to learn it, like getting stripes upon his back, by being put in jail stocks and bonds. While in the jail house he looked over at Silas and said, "Lets make this a contented placed." That is not exactly the words he used, but that is what it was. so Paul and Silas began to pray and pretty soon, I guess, they began to shout and then the stocks and bonds fell off. The jailer started to kill himself but Paul said, "Do yourself no harm we are still here, and we are content." Because they were content they had a contented jailer. During this time those that were up town became discontented and said, "Throw those men out of jail." But Paul said, "No you are

not, we are going to live out right here until you come and let us out the way you put us in. we will just make this a contentment jail.” Read on to see what else Paul has to say regarding being content.

Philippians 4:11 *Not that I speak in respect of want: for I have learned, in whatsoever state I am, therewith to be content.*

When the devil comes at you like a lion, just take the sword of contentment and pierce him. Paul continues on in verse 12.

Philippians 4:12 *I know both how to be abased, and I know how to abound*

We have to know how to be abased also, it's a hard thing to be abased, when somebody gets on your case and your abased. The first thing we want to do when we are abased is to get mad and then we have to pray through and get contented or we don't feel right. There are a lot of people in the church that are sitting around nursing their chin looking the thing over, they don't have contentment is what it is.

Philippians 4:12 *I know both how to be abased, and I know how to abound: every where and in all things I am instructed both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need. 13 I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.*

That means he had a hold of it, he said, “I'll just be content. “

Contentment brings production, and I am going to bring in a story here about a cow. Some of you may remember the advertisement, I am probably the oldest person here, but I remember some advertisements about a cow called Elsie, the contented cow. They were trying to get cows to produce

more milk and be more productive, so they got a hold of this jersey cow and they called her Elsie. They built a great big place for her to stay so she would be comfortable and she could move around, they had all the feed that she could eat all the time. They had taken her out from the rogues that were in the fields, butting each other around, I have a book on the rogue. We even have rogues in the church, and you have to get rid of the rogues, a roguish spirit won't do.

There was Elsie, they had put her in this place and they began to get all kinds of stuff set up in there that they thought would make her give more milk. This is a true story, back in the 40's, it was Elsie the contented cow that was on every Borden's sign, Borden's milk. They had her there trying to make her content, they had some kind of idea that if the cows were content they would produce more. They give her this place to stay, they gave her plenty of food, and then they decided to get some good soft classic music for her to listen to, something soothing, to see if that would help. Right away Elsie took up with it, seemed she was smarter than humans, she ate all she wanted to, and finally they even made her a water bed. They provided everything they thought would make Elsie more content and she became the most productive cow that was ever known. There are times that some of the young people need to get with some of the older people and learn some knowledge and wisdom.

As a Christian we are suppose to produce, well in the 15th chapter of the book of St. John Jesus told us that we are suppose to produce and he told us what are we suppose to produce, fruit.

That cow was producing milk and that's what they wanted her to produce, but what God wants us to produce is fruit.

John 15:8 *Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples.*

There are some things we have to do to bear much fruit, first we have to get all the old limbs off of the tree. The pruners come in and cut off the old limbs, they gather them together and burn them, but they purge the rest of the vine and it brings forth more fruit.

Godliness with contentment is great gain, its gain in production. I will guarantee you that if they put rock music in there with Elsie she would have kicked the walls down, she would have gone crazy. That is what's wrong with a whole lot of our people today, they are crazy, they are not in their right mind.

Philippians 2:5 *Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus.*

Get the mind of Christ and you will want something soothing and it will put you to work, you will begin to win souls and you will begin to produce fruit. Then when you ask the Lord what he wants he'll say more. That's what I have heard the Lord say, more, to people than anything else. When you ask the Lord what do you want me to do, he will respond with the word more. He is famous to me for saying those words, "I want more! More fruit, more souls won, more people converted." There are all kinds of things to do and people are sitting around and doing nothing. I'll tell what, you will not be content doing nothing and you will not be content down at the court house square with

the group that sits down there. We use to have a group at the square that we called the spit and whittle gang, and they would just sit there chewing and spitting tobacco and whittling and sometimes pitching horse shoes, they were not getting anything done for God. People are going to give account for idle time, there are some people who have such a load that they cant handle it, others could lift that load if they would just get up and go to work for the Lord.

I want to close right here, Paul and different ones have taught us here, just this thing with Elsie the cow, they did a whole lot of other things and that cow responded to everything that was soothing and helpful to her and she produced more milk.

This type of teaching will make your church grow. Somebody said, "I want to get into a church to where they turn somersaults, jump up and down and kick and roll", I do too, but I want it to be real. I don't want it to be something that when all the kicking and the shouting of camp meeting is over and they say, "Well we had a good camp meeting, but that is all there is to it." No, it should live in you, every church service should live in you. because it is life, **Act 17:28** *For in him we live, and move, and have our being*

In who? In Christ, there is life, He is our way, He is our truth and He is our life. There is no way to get to Fathers house except by Him. He is the godliness of this, godly, the Father, the Word and the Holy Ghost, and this can come into our life.

Matthew 6:33 *But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.*

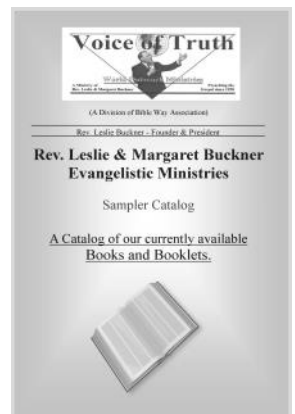

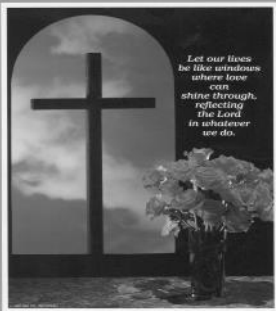
