John 3:16 For God so loved the
world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish,
but have everlasting life.

The greatest and most precious promise that God has given to mankind is the promise of everlasting life. Salvation is the beginning point in a believer's life that opens the door to a multitude of great and precious promises as a new creature in Christ.

That one-time point of salvation in our life, that free gift given through the blood sacrifice of Jesus, the gift of eternal life, is perfect, true, and is a complete package regarding his plan of salvation. Romans 14:17 For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.

John 3:3 Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

John 3:5-6 Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. 6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.

Colossians 1:26-28which is Christ in you, the hope of glory: that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus:

1 Corinthians 1:30

We must interject here the difference between how the Lord sees this new birth. In verse 6, Jesus stated that what is born of the flesh is flesh, but what is born of the Spirit is spirit, or spiritual.

This new birth was the beginning of a process that will ensue for the rest of our natural life. God wants the spiritual, born-again man to take dominion over the carnal, fleshly part of man willingly because we love him and want to be pleasing in his sight.

1 Peter 1:13-1916 Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy. 19 But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:

We are looking for the mind of God. It's about God in us, the seed in us, how a righteous heart and Godly mind will cause us to present our bodies as a living sacrifice unto God.

Brother Buckner once said. "Righteousness is a seed that is sown in us, producing a holy mind and life. Revival is budding and will come out in full bloom; a freeze can hit it though and kill it, so we must stay fired up for God! It is time for revival!" He also said, "I've had many revivals and seen many miracles and healings, and the young people need to see this also. I think the children need to see what's going on from start to finish and understand everything that the ministry of the Body of Christ is about. The children need to see the move of God and the

ministers and people on the altar praying for people's needs and seeing how revival can spring up within the church so that they can carry on. These things are a witness and a testimony of the elders unto the younger."

As a born-again child of God, we have become a new creature in Christ. We have been made partakers of the heavenly calling and the inheritance of eternity in His presence, being made free from the bondage of sin. We have begun to walk in this new life as a child under tutors and governors, spiritually speaking, that will help to guide us into maturity in Christ and our pursuit of His will.

So, now He wants us to put our hand to the plow and push forward. God wants His people to take responsibility for their life, trust him to shelter and care for us, and press ahead, putting effort into this spiritual walk so that we can be partakers of the things of God. Sometimes we have to get behind the plow a little more than others appear to; we might even have to prick the oxen and get the plow going again.

The sound purposes of being saved, sanctified and filled with

the Holy Ghost are still great truths that need to be rehearsed, ministered, and lived continually.

Ephesians 4:11-15 And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers: 12 For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifyof the body **Christ:** 13 Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:15 But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ:

I believe God wants desperately to revive the church, one person at a time. It needs to be a revival where the manifestations and works of the Spirit and the Word are not forgotten the next day; instead, a revival that becomes ingrained in our hearts leading us into conformity to His divine image, becoming partakers of His divine nature.

Romans 8:29, 2 Peter 1:4

How often have people gotten into revival services and prayed through into God's will for their life, through humility, repentance, and submission, only to return at another call for revival to accomplish the same sacrifices again regarding the same obstacle or problems in their life, thus essentially laying again, the foundation of repentance from dead works?

Many dedicated pastors, teachers, or evangelists have become discouraged at the lack of spiritual maturity because they see these patterns in the Christian life. It appears that the same efforts in ministry have to be constantly repeated, endeavoring to bring the flock unto maturity where they can learn to stand and be able to lead another brother or sister into that place of maturity and victory instead of rehearsing the same actions again and again!

Their hearts labor because they love their congregations and recognize their struggles. They know that only God, by the anointing of the Holy Ghost, can remedy these problems as we submit ourselves into his care.

It's time to grow up and begin to walk in the Spirit according to the Word of God. These old patterns can only change when each child of God begins to hunger and thirst for the fullness of the Kingdom of God in their life. Only through heartfelt humility and commitment can God's revival start within our churches and in us.

Many people have become so dedicated to the traditional directives and motivations within the church that they struggle to focus on simply submitting their bodies as a living sacrifice unto God. Let's not forget our first love.

It's almost like people aren't concerned anymore about personally seeking to "know Jesus" the way that the Apostle Paul illustrated to the church in Philippi.

Philippians 3:8-16

.......14 I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.

Let's reach forth and press for the mark, for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus. We must seek the Kingdom of God and the perfect will of God. We believe that the perfect will of God is for every one of us to be conformed to His image as represented in His Son, Jesus Christ. I believe that, but even the Apostle Paul declared that he had not yet attained or apprehended that place yet, but he went on to say that he had fought a good fight.

2 Timothy 4:6-8

Going On Unto Perfection

Hebrews 6:1-3 Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto perfection; not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works, and of faith toward God, 2 Of the doctrine of baptisms, and of laying on of hands, and of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment. 3 And this will we do, if God permit.

Then the writer of Hebrews said in Chapter 6, "Let us go on unto perfection, **not laying again...."** You see, that's the key, not laying again the foundations of childhood immaturity.

Hosea 10:12 Sow to yourselves in righteousness, reap in mercy; break up your fallow ground: for it is time to seek the LORD, till he come and rain righteousness upon you.

Galatians 2:17-18

God is telling this generation, "Let's go on," beyond the things the church has been concentrating on for ages. It's time to reach for the strong meat of the Word of God and the pressing forward into the place of maturity that God wants us to achieve.

2 Peter 1:4 Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

Individually we must spiritually mature beyond falling prey to the same temptations and weaknesses over and over and begin to take responsibility for our spiritual life, just as each adult eventually has to do in their material life to become productive in society. We need to spiritually mature beyond rehearsing again the foundation of repentance from dead works, etc. That's should be our principal focus, and we must be about our Father's business.

Psalms 107:19-20

The Word is sent to heal. At the core of our life in Christ Jesus is hungering and thirsting for illumination, revelation, understanding, and discernment by the Holy Ghost.

We pray that all can come to understand the depth of the Word of God, the Presence of God, and the Power of God. These things are the heart of what has to be demonstrated within the Body of Christ.

The fruit of the Spirit is what the Church and the world will see as evidence of the presence of God in His people, and the manifestations of this fruit will touch souls as nothing else can.

Galatians 5:22-25 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, 23 Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law. 24 And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts. 25 If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

The gifts of the Spirit are a significant part of God's plan for the Church. Through these gifts, God is glorified, and lives are changed. We desperately need to see the manifestations of the gifts of the Spirit becoming more and more frequent.

1 Corinthians 12:7-11 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal. 8 For to one is given by the Spirit the Word of wisdom; to another the Word of knowledge by the same Spirit; 9 To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; 10 To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues: 11 But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will.

God has not stopped moving; He is just waiting for the Church to catch up to His perfect plan. It's time to press into this and do our part to fulfill God's plan.

As ministers of the Gospel, we must lead, talk revival, plant churches, and minister the whole Word of God; it must start with the leadership and spread throughout the churches and all the ministry. What's In The Future?

Brother Buckner bought up adjoining houses and property as he began acquiring the campgrounds, and he used these facilities for over 50 years while pursuing the vision, working with what was here.

He knew God made the way to acquire what is here, and he used what was in his hands, being thankful for every part of it.

Buildings are not the central focus, but consider this, without a building or meeting place, how could we conduct Camp Meetings? Even when Jesus

ministered, the people had gathered together to hear Him, and somebody had to be let down through the roof to get to where he was. Are we any different than they were?

We still need places to come together and wait upon the manifestations of His will and power.

Our primary desire and goal is to keep these Camp Meetings going perpetually. If I can't do it, others with the same vision will stand up to do it. If they can't do it, God will provide someone who will, but it's going to be people pointing in the same direction and with the same God-given vision that has always been our foundation.

As I was thinking about these things, I realized we must have a way to bridge the past and the future together. Camp Meetting is that key!



Next Steps

We can sit here with detailed plans and a plot map of every inch of these 55 acres that the Association has acquired, but until we put our hands to the plow and begin to work with it, it remains just thoughts and possibilities. It's not that we are trying to disassemble anything that has been established; instead, we want to promote the continuation of what God has already put in place.

At one time, I counted nearly 60 rooms here for people to come and stay during camp meetings. They weren't Hilton Hotel quality, but they were places to rest and sleep. People were bringing their tents and campers, and we managed 200 to 300 people with bare necessities. For years, we had only two shower houses, one for men and one for women, and people were okay with it because God was moving.

Those early facilities have broken down and have become almost entirely unusable through the years. Instead of having nearly 60 rooms, we now have around 20.

Most of the older buildings are just old houses built many years ago, and we've been able to continue using them until now. But, they have all become unusable and dangerous.

We aren't turning away from the need, but we continue to put our hand to the plow. We can't bring Brother Buckner back, but the visions he's had and the work he has begun will continue. He has passed the torch and the vision, so I and others feel a similar, if not the same God-given passion and calling for this ministry that he had.

Many ministers and friends have been faithful to come to camp and other meetings who understand and recognize what we have and are willing and excited to participate in the continuing progression.

So it's time to take what's been instilled in us and move on. It's time to remove what has become unusable for the ministry's sake. We will begin by tearing down the old buildings that have become unusable and are not repairable.









One of the first benefits will be opening up the view to allow the Tabernacle building to be the first thing seen from the highway.


We want to take the heritage left us as a group of ministers and churches and make it more accessible where more people can come.

Even though we live in a tumultuous time, God knows the day and the hour and what's happening around us. I know churches where people are trying to tear them apart from the outside by interfering in the congregations and sowing discord by planting different ideas among them.

Beware, ministers; these are not ordinary times like we have all been used to. Things are not the same as they were 40 years ago, and the enemy is still out to kill, steal, and destroy. Let's be about our Father's business, remembering that even Jesus said, "and take heed" and "watch and pray." Now is not the time to let down our guard. It's time to raise the standard and trust God

A New Office Building

In addition to clearing out the old unusable buildings, we have decided to build a new office building that will be more suited and properly designed.



We can remodel the old office building into more rooms for people to stay in when they come to the meetings.



The Lord is already providing! Most of the lumber for the new office has already been donated. I have a reasonable estimate for concrete for the foundation and floor. Several new windows have been donated, and we have more and more donations coming! We also have CVT flooring, just like what is in the back of the Tabernacle, ready to install at no extra purchase cost except for the adhesives. We will be putting in six new office spaces and a work area for our printing and for publications, books, tapes, and everything else we are doing, as well as places for staff and board meetings.

I believe God is supplying what we need, and we've been saving for quite a while to be able to begin these projects. However, adding rooms for campers to use is our primary motivation.

Additional Sleeping Rooms and Cabins

We have had a lot of interest in people wanting to build cabins. We have one started that we're expecting to be completed by spring. Our plans are for each of these cabins to have bathrooms with showers.

When people invest in these cabins, they will have the first option to come and use them. If they can't come during any meeting, somebody else will be allowed to use them

These cabins can also be a place where our ministers can come, with prior notification, anytime during the year as a short-term retreat or resting place.

Our current plans may include Bible Way Association investing in the infrastructure with power, water, and sewer facilities allowing those who choose to participate, help us fund or assemble the rooms..

Anyone that invests will never have ownership in that property because our corporate structure and purposes will not allow that. The cabins will have to remain Bible Way's property, but the investor will always have priority anytime they want to come.

The dorm was built with girls and boys sides, primarily for youth. We plan to put a full-size bed in each of those rooms plus the bunk beds to make it more adult-friendly for families and youth when it is needed to easily accommodate the other needs

New Walkway

We are getting ready to pour concrete walkways between the Tabernacle and the dormitory building to allow easy walking between the buildings with landings at both ends of the Dormitory so they will be completely handicap accessible. We have handicapped bathrooms and handicap accessible rooms, but it's currently a little difficult to get in the building easily or easily walk between these two buildings.

Handicap Access Between The Tabernacle and The Dining Hall

We also have plans to improve handicap access between the Tabernacle and the Dining Hall in time to come and as finances allow. By increasing the size of the entry way and moving the sound room, this can happen

We have promises of people wanting to help us accomplish these things. People have begun to catch the vision! One man that was here said, "You know, I'm new in Bible Way, but when I came driving in, he thought, man, what did I get myself into?" It isn't the buildings, brothers, and sisters, but by the time he was ready to leave, he said, I agree with

the vision, I'm part of it, I want to help do what I can.

All I'm trying to say is that the original vision will not die on the vine. We want to see this Association progress and prosper, so let's all push towards God's plan for deeper Spiritual commitments and improve the facilities already here.

.Camp Meetings, Fellowship Meetings,. Etc.

Prayerfully we can continue having several small Camp Meetings throughout next year, but we desire to get back into full Camp Meetings again.

I've even had thoughts, and am praying, about bringing some people together to take ministry with music and singing into several other locations, by pulling ministers and churches together having minicamp meetings in other areas instead of just expecting it all to come here.

We want to reach out; we're hungry to see God and the power of God promoted and lifted up because it's not about having everything here in Doniphan; even though we have good facilities, it's about anything we can all work together and accomplish for the Kingdom of God; that's the vision.

Keepers of the Camp

We have a program that started several years ago that I appreciate. Keepers of the Camp is a program that has been around for 10-15 years providing small monthly donations to help with cleaning, painting, mowing, and repairs. Keepers of the Camp is something where you could pledge a donation every month, or give a one-time donation, to support the camp grounds and improve them. It's a11 about the future campground vision to make things more comfortable and accessible for those who will come.

The **Keepers of the Camp** program currently only has two churches supporting it, along with four individuals, and I'm thankful to be one of them. I am just saying I believe in what we're doing, and I'm personally investing in it.
