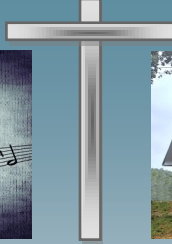

Restoring Paths For Your Feet

Matthew 3:10

- 1 *In those days came John the Baptist, preaching in the wilderness of Judaea,*
- 2 *And saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.*
- 3 *For this is he that was spoken of by the prophet Esaias, saying, The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make his paths straight.*
- 4 *And the same John had his raiment of camel's hair, and a leathern girdle about his loins; and his meat was locusts and wild honey.*
- 5 *Then went out to him Jerusalem, and all Judaea, and all the region round about Jordan,*

6 *And were baptized of him in Jordan, confessing their sins*

7 *But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees come to his baptism, he said unto them, O generation of vipers, who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come*

8 *Bring forth therefore fruits meet for repentance:*

9 *And think not to say within yourselves, We have Abraham to our father: for I say unto you, that God is able of these stones to raise up children unto Abraham.*

10 *And now also the axe is laid unto the root of the trees: therefore every tree which bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire.*

I see a picture, the Lord is getting ready to come at his first coming. The last prophet in the Old Testament and the one that was saying prepare ye the way of the Lord, took the pulpit on the banks of the river Jordan and began to preach that the Lord was coming. He began to preach “*Prepare ye the way of the Lord and make his paths straight.*” Notice, he said, “*Paths.*”

The Paths We Must Observe

Hebrews 12:13 *And make straight paths for your feet,*

I was reading of some paths in the Bible.

Proverbs 2:20

it's “a path of righteousness”

Psalms 25:10

the “path is mercy and truth”

Proverbs 3:17

“all his paths are the way of peace”

Matthew 3:3

“his paths are straight”

Psalms 27:11

“his paths are plain”

Psalms 16:11

it is a *“path of life”*

Isaiah 35:8

it's “a highway and the highway shall be called holiness”

I see the great prophet John, the last of the old prophets saying, *prepare ye the way of the Lord and make straight his paths*. Not one path, but paths straight. In other words, the Lord, when he came, was going to come walking and he wasn't going to be walking a crooked path.

Dealing With The Wrong Ways

There hadn't been a prophet in Israel for four hundred years, a path grows up pretty good after four hundred years. The path had already grown up and it was full of thorns and thistles. He said, *“Get the axe out and lay the axe at the root of the trees”*. Every tree that doesn't bear fruit and has thorns, cut it down. *“Make the path straight.”* We have every kind of a doctrine today. People seem to be confused, in a wilderness walking in circles. No one would cut a path in a circle, except the children of Israel that stayed in the wilderness for forty years and walked in a circle. A path goes somewhere. Usually a person that is going somewhere wants to get there as quick as they can and to the best of their ability, so they make the

path straight. John was saying, “The Lord is coming and he is going to start marching through and get out the axe and begin to lay the axe to the root of the trees. Every tree that doesn't bring forth good fruit, hew it down, it will be cast into the fire.” He said, “Every tree that brings forth good fruit, I'll purge it so it will bring forth more fruit.”

Paths Lead Us Somewhere

A path goes somewhere, a path of righteousness goes somewhere. A path of Holiness goes somewhere, a path of peace goes somewhere, and a path of mercy goes somewhere. One scripture says, the old paths (**Jeremiah 6:16**).

It seems as if everyone wants to get some kind of a new path and it doesn't go anywhere. It goes off down the road somewhere and it ends. Then, they come back and they have to start all over again. It says *not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works, and of faith toward God (Hebrews 6:1)*. God wants the church to rise up and get in the path, cut out the path. The Lord is coming! He is going to be walking straight. Make straight paths for your feet and walk therein.

Where do paths go? It's time that the church surveys, “Where am I going? What is my destination? What is my purpose?” John the Baptist was preaching repent for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand. He was a voice of one crying in the wilderness. His voice said, “Prepare ye the way of the Lord.” His voice said, “Make his paths straight.”

There hadn't been a true prophet for four hundred years and his voice said that the path was grown up. It was his voice that said, "Get the axe out and lay it at the root of the tree. Every tree that doesn't bear fruit has to be cut down." We are in a time that God is chopping the trees down. Make his paths straight. The fruit of repentance was required even for baptism.

What does our church require today? What is a Christian? Adam walked with God. In **Genesis 5:22**, it says, "*Enoch walked with God and was no more because God took him.*" If we are going to walk with God, we are talking about the rapture of the church. It's going to take a walk with God to go anywhere. We are going to have to walk with God; we have walked with each other long enough, it is time to walk with God. What was the prophet saying? The axe is laid at the root of the trees, not tree, but trees.

Matthew 3:10 *And now also the axe is laid unto the root of the trees: therefore every tree which bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire.*

Hebrews 12:12 *Wherefore lift up the hands which hang down, and the feeble knees; 13 And make straight paths for your feet, lest that which is lame be turned out of the way; but let it rather be healed.*

God is wanting a healing. He wants a spiritual healing for people. God wants to heal, but he said, "*Make straight paths.*" We will find healing in the path, we will also find blessings, power, glory and the fruit

of the spirit in the path. In the path we will find the gifts of the Spirit. In the path we will find ministries that have the five fold ministry and the power of God speaking the truth in love, growing up in him, and all things which is the head even Christ from whom the whole body fitly joins together.

Paths Are Created By Our Walk

Paths are made by feet, the more feet that go over the path, the plainer the path. Make straight paths for your feet. Feet are what walks. He said his paths are plain, are righteous, are mercy, are peace and are truth. His paths are the paths of Holiness. A lot of people think that the doctrine of the apostles is water baptism. Some people think Holiness starts on the outside and goes in. No, it starts on the inside and works out. God looks upon the heart and doesn't look upon the outward appearance of man. When the heart gets right, we will look right on the outside. The Bible says clean up the inside of the platter that the outside might become clean also. God is calling the church to a straight way and narrow way.

Matthew 7:14 *Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.*

That's Biblical, that is what Jesus said. There are multitudes of people in churches, but very few in the path.

Broad is the way, who has heard of making a path forty miles wide? You would get lost in the path. A lot

of people are making the path so broad that people are getting lost in it. The children of Israel went across the wilderness and the path was so broad that they were getting lost in the path. The church today is living so loose, so ungodly, and so unholy that people are getting lost in the path trying to follow someone. Jesus said, "*Follow me and I will make you fishers of men.*" If you follow Jesus, you are going to walk in the path because he is going to walk in the path and he is going to walk straight. "*Strait is the gate.*"

The Lord was coming. The messenger had the platform. The messenger is going to tell you how to go, where to go, how to get there, and what's there when you get there. The true messenger. There is one place in the Bible that the messenger came running in and forgot what the message was. What was the penalty for forgetting a message? Death.

Romans 8:6 *For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.*

To be carnally minded is a death penalty. They that are in the flesh can not please God. There are two things that cannot please God. One is:

Hebrews 11:6 *But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.*

Two is:

Romans 8:8 *So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.*

When Flesh Gets In Our Way

The flesh bears no fruit. It produces the seventeen works of the flesh.

The paths were overgrown, it had been four hundred years, it had grown up with thorns and thistles. John said, "*Prepare ye the way of the Lord. Make his paths straight.*" Get out the axe.

You don't have to if you want to dilly-dally around with people that won't do it anyway. They will take you anyway. They will make the path so broad that anyone can get in it, but strait is the gate and narrow is the way that leadeth unto life. It's a fruitful way.

Paths go somewhere. Where do they go? We have no farther to go than in the book of Exodus to find where the path of the Lord will take us. When Moses and the children of Israel became obedient to the Lord, God assembled six hundred thousand plus a mixed multitude and the path took them out of the land of Egypt, a land of sin, sorrow, and pressure. A straight path will take us out of sin. Paths go somewhere, they don't stay in Egypt. People that are walking in the path don't stay in sin.

Romans 6:1 *What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?*

Who can we lean on? Who can we trust? We can turn to and we can trust the person who has the fruit, who is fighting the good fight of faith, the person that is in the path, that is walking with God, that is liv-

ing for God. That is who we can trust and no one else. God has no confidence in the flesh. Israel wanted to be like the rest of the world one time and got themselves a king. A lot of people want a preacher like the rest of the world. Paths lead us out of sin.

A path leads us through the obstacles. Some people never get out of Egypt and never get out of the obstacles. The first thing when they came out of Egypt, they came to the Red Sea. All of sudden, they looked behind them and saw Pharaoh's army coming. Moses forgot about the rod and the path. The path of the Lord goes anywhere, through anything. The path doesn't quit when we run into obstacles. Moses said to the people, "Stand still and see the salvation of the Lord."

God Said Go Forward

The Bible said in **Exodus 14:15** *And the LORD said unto Moses, Wherefore criest thou unto me? speak unto the children of Israel, that they go forward: 16 But lift thou up thy rod,*

Where were they going to but through the sea? There was no place else to go. Have you heard the saying between the devil and the deep blue sea? That is where they were at. Someone said, "One time that wasn't a miracle; the sea was not but knee deep in that place." Someone else spoke up and said, "Then it's a greater miracle because the whole Egyptian army drowned in knee deep water." God said to Moses, "What's that you have in your hand? Raise it up to the Red Sea." And the waters began to divide and the wind began

to blow. It made a path through the sea, they went straight through. They didn't wander around ten years in the sea. They went straight through. Paths go through the obstacles. The quicker you go through the obstacles, the better it is. When they got through the obstacle, on the other side of the sea, they started singing and shouting.

Hebrews 12:12 *Wherefore lift up the hands which hang down, and the feeble knees; 13 And make straight paths for your feet, lest that which is lame be turned out of the way; but let it rather be healed.*

The world can't find the path anymore, we are going to have to get our axe and chop it out. We are going to have to make his paths straight. We are going to have to bear fruit, we are going to have to get the axe. If any brush gets in the way, we will chop it out so we can walk with him.

Hearts Burn When We Walk With Jesus

Luke 24:32 *And they said one to another, Did not our heart burn within us, while he talked with us by the way, and while he opened to us the scriptures?*

A path will lead us through a wilderness of confusion. We can survive in the desert, but we can't survive in the wilderness. It takes God to get us through the wilderness. Israel had to have manna, had to have the rock that followed them, and that rock was Christ. They couldn't survive in the wilderness without a supernatural power. No

one survives in the confusion without the supernatural power of God and the devil is the author of confusion.

James 3:16 *For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work.*

No one survives confusion without God. You don't know which direction to go because every one is going in a different direction. The path will lead us through the confusion. When Jesus went into the wilderness, he didn't spend forty years in there. He whipped the devil on his own ground. He came out in the power of the Spirit. God wants us to come out in the power of the Spirit. Israel wandered in the desert for forty years, around and around. Finally, they got enough people together that didn't have any confusion, people that would obey. People that won't obey are hindrances. God said, "Joshua, you are going to cross over in three days. Prepare your victuals and get ready to go". The Bible said they gave the priests the ark of the covenant. They began to walk, they walked right up to the river Jordan.

According to history, the river Jordan was out of its banks at that time of the year. When they quit walking in circles in the wilderness, they quit the problems, the envy and strife, the confusion, and they began to walk in the path, the straight path. The Bible says when the priests' feet touched the river that the waters divided and they went across on dry ground. Paths will lead you through troubled waters, a straight path. A crooked path will lead you through another circle in the wilderness. They got through the waters. The

only place I find where they walked a circle was when they got to the wall. It didn't take forty years to get around the wall. A lot of people spend forty years messing with someone who has gotten themselves in a wall. Without the power of God, they are going to stay in that wall. They had the armies on top of the wall.

Victory For Joshua "The Victory March"

Joshua 6:2 *And the LORD said unto Joshua, See, I have given into thine hand Jericho, and the king thereof, and the mighty men of valour. 3 And ye shall compass the city, all ye men of war, and go round about the city once. Thus shalt thou do six days. 4 And seven priests shall bear before the ark seven trumpets of rams' horns: and the seventh day ye shall compass the city seven times, and the priests shall blow with the trumpets 5 And it shall come to pass, that when they make a long blast with the ram's horn, and when ye hear the sound of the trumpet, all the people shall shout with a great shout; and the wall of the city shall fall down flat, and the people shall ascend up every man straight before him.*

If we walk with God, walls will come down.

What is fellowship? Some people think fellowship is when you have a chicken dinner. Some people think fellowship is when you go to a fellowship meeting and everybody shouts. Fellowship means to be a community, or to be a body, to be a partaker. I thought when God put

two men in perfect fellowship together, like Paul and Silas, or Peter and John, what a great fellowship that was. The Bible says if we are going to rule with him, we are going to suffer with him. It was wonderful when they received blessings, but if one got whipped and thrown in jail, they both did because they were in fellowship with one another. That is what's wrong with our churches. When a problem arises, everyone goes where they are shouting.

A straight path will take you through fellowship. Can you imagine when they went around the wall and all of a sudden the trumpet sounded, they shouted and the wall fell flat? That was unity, that was obedience. All of a sudden the trumpet sounded and the wall fell flat. Can you imagine how that army on the wall felt when all of a sudden they were looking the Israelites right in the eye? Paths of the Lord will lead you around the wall and destroy the division. They were divided from the children of Israel. What's wrong with churches, and preachers is that they are divided. Churches are divided because preachers are divided. The husbandman that laboureth must be the first partaker of the fruit.

Taking Your Mountain

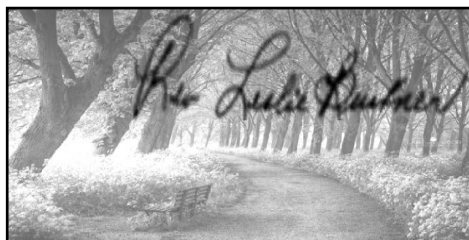
They didn't stay there and keep walking around the wall, they headed for the mountain. They headed for the promise, paths will lead you to the promises of God. They left the wall, they quit walking in circles. The only thing that stopped them for a while was sin. Remember Achen? Disobedience. They moved from the wall and went to the mountain.

Paths won't lead you away from the fight, they will lead you into the fight. Some people are so used to running every time a problem rises, they are what you call skittish. They are skittish of everything. They are afraid the devil is going to rise up and destroy the church. He won't in the path. Paul said:

2 Timothy 4:7 *I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith: 8 Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness,*

Caleb and the children of Israel went up against the giants. They killed the giants after they got sin out of the camp. They were walking on the highway of Holiness. They got sin out of the camp and when they got to the giants, they killed them. There are giants standing in your way between you and the promises. When they killed the giants, Caleb walked upon the mountain and said, "Give me this day my mountain." Joshua began to divide the inheritance to the people.

Paths will lead you to your inheritance. Make straight paths for your feet. Prepare ye the way of the Lord. Get the axe out, chop out the briar patch, cut down the thorn trees, leave the fruit trees and make straight paths for your feet and walk therein.

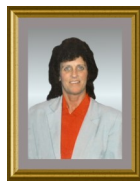
