On September 26, 2024, at 11:10 p.m. EDT, NOAA's GOES East satellite captured Hurricane Helene making landfall near Perry, Florida, just east of the Aucilla River's mouth. With winds reaching 140 mph, the Category 4 storm ranks among the most powerful to strike the United States, according to noaa.gov. Helene continued to move upward, spanning a 500-mile path of destruction. On September 27, 2024, the Appalachian mountains of Western North Carolina (WNC) experienced something that is being called unprecedented devastation of Biblical proportions in this area of WNC that one would typically think would be considered isolated from the impacts of hurricanes. Helene also caused destruction in East Tennessee, South Carolina, Virginia, and Georgia.

As Hurricane Helene made landfall in Florida, it is noted to be the strongest hurricane on record to strike Florida's Big Bend region and the deadliest to strike the mainland U.S. since Hurricane Katrina in 2005, according to Wikipedia. Within a span of 4 hours, Helene quickly strengthened from a Category 2 hurricane to a Category 4 hurricane that left this 500-mile path of destruction. Wind gusts of hurricane force - up to 100mph- were measured well into the mountains of North Carolina and Virginia, and numerous locations received 12 to 31 inches of rain between Sept. 25-27.

As the media outlets are primarily displaying the destruction in Asheville, we want to also focus and bring attention to the small town of Burnsville, NC where we lived for over a year, and the surrounding small towns of Celo, Micaville, Spruce Pine, Bakersville, Pensacola and Swannanoa.

While we don't want to downplay the destruction that has spanned this 500-mile path of Helene, this region of the Appalachia in WNC was our home for a short season of our life.

This place is gorgeous, with creeks around every corner and homes nestled by them on the edge of the mountains.



As communications were thoroughly wiped out and not accessible in the area, these small communities rallied together and supported one another with no contact from the 'outside world' and had no idea. the such large scale of destruction that had just occurred.



We have family friends, memories, new friends, and a Church family there. A piece of our heart will always be a part of WNC.

With the cellular network system down, some relied upon internet connection to maintain their employment and prevent losing their job, such as Jonathan who needed a way to support his sweet family of 3.

Jonathan, alongside his wife Hope and their 3 year old little boy, Asher has been providing nourishing meals to neighbors and volunteering at a local church, however, with no foreseeable promise of having internet service to do his work from home, they were in danger of losing his job.

This is where your giving to Bible Way has already made a difference. We made the trip to North Carolina mid-October to check on Jonathan and his family and to deliver a Starlink Satellite system from Bible Way to help him save his employment. This seems like such a small way, when the devastation was on such a massive scale, but every little bit counts.



While we were in Burnsville, NC checking on this family, we wanted to see the destruction firsthand and see how effectively we could help. Every day there is slow, small progress happening.

While there, we also visited a family-owned business that provides feed and household supplies for barnyard animals. As we visited with Chris and Emily, the owners of Sasquatch Dog Supplies, we asked them what their most significant need was and how we could help them. They said absolutely nothing; God had protected them, and He had been providing. This is just one example of the sense of community and faith. But as we continued talking with them, she pulled out a stack of envelopes and shared with us that those envelopes represented families they had allowed to buy from their store "on credit" until they got back on their feet and could pay their bills. For some, she doesn't even expect to be able to receive payment back.

Not only have they helped families in this capacity, but because of their business, they have a connection with people in the area and have been a connecting point for many who are hurting people in dire need. Through this relationship, they have been able to donate to help their customers who are in severe and dire need. **Chris and Emily** operate this Christian family-owned business as an add-on addition to their home. People drive from all over the area to seek for their support until they can recover from this devastation.

No one could have ever thought that these creeks would ever turn into rivers and flood homes, thoroughly washing them away down these newly created rivers, flooding entire communities, and causing landslides. Some places are still impassible. Search and Rescue is not over; restoring and rebuilding is not over. It will take months, even years and still life will never be the same. Some are still without power, and as linemen are working tirelessly, the mountains in the areas above 3,500 ft. elevation are now experiencing snow.

It's people like Chris and Emily, Jonathan and Hope- people helping people and being Jesus' hands and feet. Their work is crucial, and your sup-

port can make a significant difference. Don't forget them. Don't forget these small communities. Your donation, no matter how small, can help rebuild lives. #### **Let's Humble Ourselves**

There are many things to take away from the present crisis in the world today. As I prayed, and meditated one morning, my attention is drawn to the idea of true humility.

The following scripture in Deuteronomy gives us insight into one of the aspects of fiery trials. We know that God works many things through trials. But in this case, He wanted Israel to know what was in their own hearts. It was important for them/us to know if we are going to follow the Lord.

**Deuteronomy 8:2 KJV** And thou shalt remember all the way which the LORD thy God led thee these forty years in the wilderness, to humble thee, and to prove thee, to know what was in thine heart, whether thou wouldest keep his commandments, or no.

God not only deals with us as individuals, or as Christians, but also as nations. In the following scriptures it is obvious that there was an attitude in this Babylonian system of self-pride and arrogance. Whether this chapter represents Israel today, or America (as some believe), it is important to realize that anyone can fall under this attitude. We live in a time in America, and probably much of the rest of the world, that we feel self-sufficient without God. I am not speaking as Christians here, but as the world. Every time we have had a crisis, whether it be the Iraq war, 9-11 terrorist bombings, or the present coronavirus, I see the same attitude. "We will beat this thing."

During the Iraq war that broke out a few years ago, the majority of Americans went to their synagogues, mosques, and churches, and had candlelight vigils in the streets. We cried out to God, implored Him to move on our behalf. He did. Then the vigils stopped, the candles were extinguished, the church lights went off, and we busted open the booze and had parties in the streets. Songs were written about how you don't mess with America or we will do this and that to you. We sit a queen and am no widow. No doubt, if God would eradicate this virus from off the face of the map tomorrow, we would boast how our doctors were the best, our policies, our intelligence took care of the problem. Some references would be made to God, but mostly, man would take the credit. The following scriptures tell me that when we have this attitude, God will humble us.

**Revelation 18:7 KJV** How much she hath glorified herself, and lived deliciously, so much torment and sorrow give her: for she saith in her heart, I sit a queen, and am no widow, and shall see no sorrow.

**Revelation 18:8** Therefore shall her plagues come in one day, death, and mourning, and famine; and she shall be utterly burned with fire: for strong is the Lord God who judgeth her.

#### To sum up these thoughts, look at these two scriptures from 2 Chronicles.

- 2 Chronicles 7:14 KJV If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- 2 Chronicles 34:27 KJV Because thine heart was tender, and thou didst humble thyself before God, when thou heardest his words against this place, and against the inhabitants thereof, and humbledst thyself before me, and didst rend thy clothes, and weep before me; I have even heard thee also, saith the LORD.

In both of the Scriptures, God speaks of people who would humble themselves. If Christians, or nations, will humble themselves before God, He will be merciful and spare us. He will deliver, and He will bless us. But if our hearts get filled with pride, He will humble us. That process is not pleasant to say the least. Yes, plagues and wilderness experiences are involved also.

According to 2 Chronicles 7:14, we are in a place that we can plead for the souls of our family, our country, and even for all nations.

#### Oh Christians, let's humble ourselves.

God has given us the awesome responsibility to pray for our fellow Americans and our fellow man. Would you join me in taking time to seek God for grace for all of mankind? Let's pray that God will touch the hearts of people everywhere and remind them of their need, and our need for Him.

# Deliver us from pride, oh Lord, and deliver us from evil, for Thine is the Kingdom and the Power and the Glory forever and ever. Amen.

## WE NEED REVIVAL NOW!

#### Matthew 5:48 KJV

48 Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.

#### Philippians 3:12-14 KJV

- 12 Not as though I had already attained, either were already perfect: but I follow after, if that I may apprehend that for which also I am apprehended of Christ Jesus.
- 13 Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before,
- 14 I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.

The process of years, months, weeks and days continues to progress swiftly, no matter how we want to break down our current events. Every year, every anniversary, every birthday and even every holiday just continues to verify that another year has come and is almost gone. Time waits for no man, woman or child, and no one has the ability to determine how many years, months, weeks or years that anyone of us may have left to serve the Lord of Glory.

We always tend to make plans for our lives, often over and over again, but how often are we able to fulfill those plans and make them become a reality.

Our lives are constantly changing with its uplifting times of joy, happiness, good health and prosperity. We are always excited and thrilled when the goodness of God is revealed in our lives and we feel his mighty presence and power.

Likewise, at times we may also face uncertainties, challenges, sadness, heartbreak or sickness which weigh us down until God comes on the scene and lifts us up again. (Romans 5:1-5 KJV)

Through all of the times in our lives we all certainly need to draw nearer to God and allow the Holy Ghost to refresh, renew and revive our soul and spirit to secure the prize of the high calling of God.

Given this, we should, and must learn, through these challenges that the need for revival and refreshing in our hearts is seldom fulfilled adequately to bring us to the place of preparedness that God wants us to achieve.

#### Philippians 4:11-13 KJV

- II Not that I speak in respect of want: for I have learned, in whatsoever state I am, therewith to be content.
- 12 I know both how to be abased, and I know how to abound: every where and in all things I am instructed both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need.
- 13 I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.

#### Romans 5:1-5 KJV

- 1 Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:
- 2 By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.
- 3 And not only so, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience;
- 4 And patience, experience; and experience, hope:
- 5 And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.

#### James 4:6-10 KJV

- 6 But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble.
- 7 **Submit yourselves** therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
- 8 **Draw nigh to God**, and **he will draw nigh to you**. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded.
- 9 Be afflicted, and mourn, and weep: let your laughter be turned to mourning, and your joy to heaviness.
- 10 Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up.

I long believed that the truest sense of attaining the stature in Christ that God has planned for our lives requires the four phased action that are described in James 4:6-10.

- 1. To truly <u>humble ourselves</u> in the presence of God and man.
- 2. To truly make the effort to submit ourselves to God's plan and will.
- 3. To bravely and honestly **resist the devil** and force him to flee.
- 4. To prayerfully draw nigh to God in Spirit and in Truth.
- 5. Then, God can draw near to us and this is the point where revival begins.

We must know and understand that nothing will ever change in our life unless we take the time, and make the efforts, to reach forward for Gods very best.

1. HUMBLE, or humility is not a momentary state of being, rather it is a place of self-recognition of who we really are before the presence of God. This is also a basic part of "taking up our cross" to come and follow Jesus. This action couples itself with "Submit".

Luke 9:23-24 KJV

Submitting ourselves under the authority, the will and the purpose of God in our life is one of the most critically necessary actions we must bring ourselves in line with in the will of God. We must become submitted to the employer on our job, this is much the same, we must therefore obey and be as Jesus was, not doing our will and what we deem to be right in our thoughts, but rather what we have seen and heard of the Master in His Word.

3. RESIST THE DEVIL It is often said and repeated that we just can't stop this, or start that, or get away from the temptations that keep us bound from walking in the Spirit and living in the Spirit as God desires us to do. The Apostle Paul wrote that God "will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it." This again is where we must decide to "take up our cross" to come and follow Jesus.

Humility, submission to God, and resisting every temptation that draws us away from God will enable the power of God to become our strength, deliverer and savior.

- James 1:14 KJV But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed.
- 1 Corinthians 10:13 KJV There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it.

#### 4. DRAW NIGH TO GOD AND HE WILL DRAW NIGH TO YOU.
