2024 Ministers' Renewal and Refreshing Retreat

Leslie Buckner over 65 years ago, and we are endeavoring to press forward to fulfill the purposes and the will of God as given.

James 4:6-8 KJV

Luke 14:27 KJV And whosoever doth not bear his cross, and come after me, cannot be my disciple.

This year is something <u>BRAND NEW!</u> The new Youth Camp Committee has been working diligently in getting plans and scheduling developed together. By June Camp Meeting, we will have the schedule posted and shared on the website so be looking for that! We have support actively coming in to fulfill this vision the Lord has laid on our hearts! Thank you so much for your prayers and support in this endeavor!

We strive in our Youth Camps to lead them to the way of Salvation in Jesus Christ and point them towards the Holy Ghost while providing them with a mixture of honoring our civil servants to allowing for good, fun filled activities.

How many ways can we say "We're Excited"

God began to place in our hearts late last year about offering the Youth Camp in 2024 completely free of charge for all of the children and the adult staff members who are registered to come and participate.

Bible Way Association has never been able to accomplish this type of program until this year, and by the help of the Lord and your generous support and giving, this will be the first of many such opportunities to see this happen and to see everything improve for the Youth Camps of the future.

Just the thought of this possibility has been so uplifting and the more it has been announced, the more it grows.

I have always felt it was a difficult thing for many families to struggle to raise the funds to send their children to Youth Camp. I do remember the struggles associated with sending our children to Youth Camp over the years. It was often more than we could accomplish, so I can feel compassion for those who find themselves in this dilemma who feel it would be good for their children to attend. Many lives have been changed over the years through these efforts.

On top of the funding for the children there remains the need for adults who desire to help in the Camps to come up with added funds to enable them to attend, sometimes when they are sacrificing time at work, or their vacation time, and still having to spend their money in this manner after their sacrifices.

The costs associated with hosting a Youth Camp have always been substantial, and we have always tried to keep the fees to a minimum while trying to supply what is needed, but as everyone is all to aware of, the costs of everything has continued to rise significantly. It cost much more this year for the food, utilities, insurances, etc. on top of the much needed repairs that are necessary to accommodate a normal camp.

The support and encouragement for this effort has truly been amazing and we want to say <u>"THANK YOU" to everyone</u> who has given already to help us see this come to pass. Every donation and offering will go ex-

clusively for the purpose of eliminating the charges and fees for the campers and paying the costs related to supplying their needs. Anything left over of these funds will be used to prepare for the next Youth Camp or improvements to the Youth Camp facilities to help us provide for more children next year.

We are expecting a maximum turnout this year due to these changes. The only problem we have recognized is the limited space to house the children and the staff.

Therefore we are forced to put the limitations of allowing participants to come on a <u>first come - first serve</u> basis in order to prevent over filling the housing facilities and creating a dangerous situation by forcing too many into each room.

Safety is our first priority!

We only have 8 rooms in the boys side and 8 rooms in the girls side. We are currently able to allow for 48 girls and 48 boys in the Dormitory along with a Dorm Attendant in each room to oversee the children.

We must currently reserve a couple of rooms on each end of the Dormitory for the adult staff members who are not Dorm Attendants. Please be aware that any adult who attends, who are not known by us, or who are recommended by their Pastors, must have a moderate background check to verify that they can be approved to be in those accommodations.

Although this is looking like the necessary pattern for things, we may be able to extend that capacity by as many as 16 more boys and 16 more girls and 4 more Dorm attendants if we are able to finish the preparation of more rooms in another building to accommodate housing for the extra adult Staff members.

We need your prayers that we can accomplish this, because this would allow for much more to happen.

I am feeling very confident that the financial needs will be met this year, but we will also need dedicated adults who are willing to come and staff these efforts to make this Youth Camp possible. Money isn't the only need, we will need your help to assist in overseeing these children and leading them to the Lord.

Looking forward to those things which are before, I believe we can

see much more happen in the coming years for these children. While this year may be funded when it comes time, we must think ahead to next year and what we all want to see for the next year regarding our youth.

I have submitted a plan to all who feel led of God to participate that by working together we can look forward to making this happen for years to come, as well as seeing improvement to the facilities and activities for the children.

We are asking for people to pray and ask God what He would have you to do relating to funding these efforts.

Our plan is as follows:

For every dollar that is donated, either as a one-time donation, or preferably on a monthly donation of any amount, a full 40% can go to supply for this funding and for future improvement as the amounts allow for those improvements. Funding for the Youth Camp fees first, secondly for the improvements.

Another 40% will be used to help cover the expenses related to the Camp Meetings and other special meeting throughout the year. We want to make more such activities possible in the years to come.

The remaining 20% will be used to supply the needs to improvement on the facilities for the Campgrounds and to help meet the needs relating to those facilities.

In other words, while we are willing to put everything we can get a hold of into these efforts, we cannot do this ourselves. We need your support for these needs to make the future possible, by the grace and provisions of the Lord. While he is able to provide abundantly, he most often uses his servants to be His supply, seldom does it miraculously appear without the moving of the Spirit of God on the hearts of His servants and people.

Please pray about what God would have you to do, if anything, and we will be pray that God would richly bless your efforts for the work of the ministry and for the future of those children. In Jesus Name.
